## Guidelines for Holiday Homework:

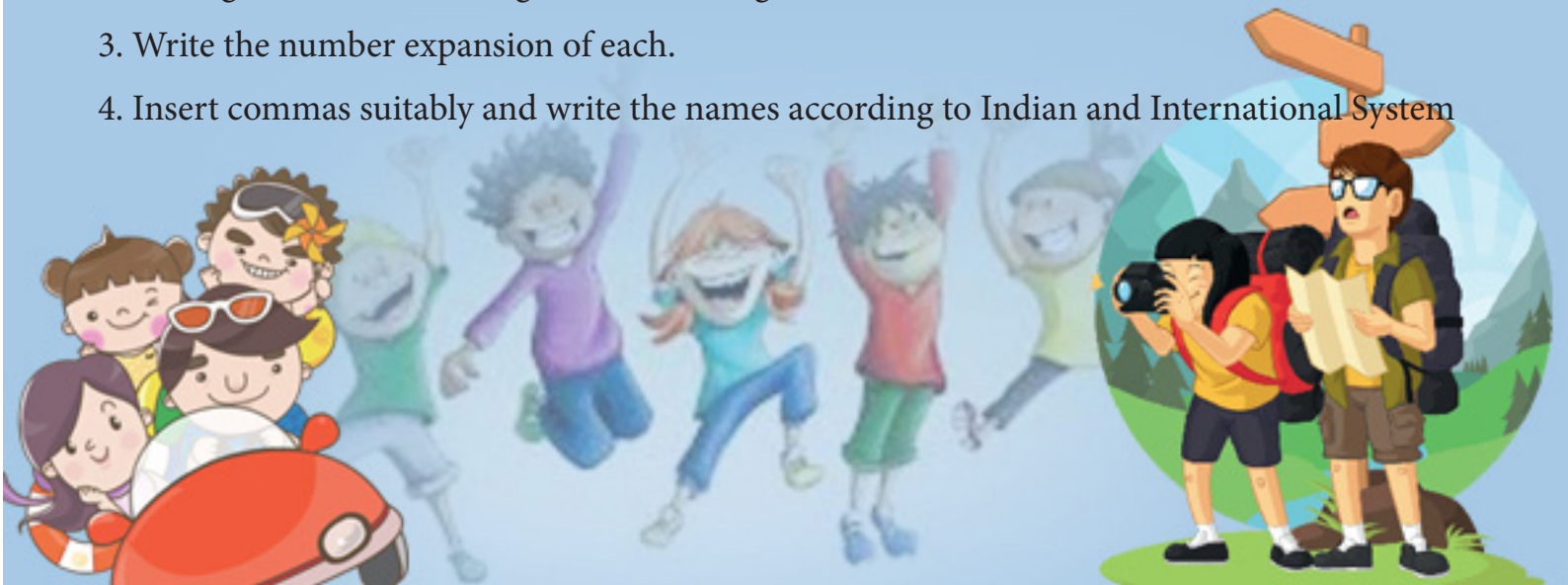
Revise the content covered in the month of April .Do your holiday homework neatly and in an organised manner.
