Silambam is an Ancient Martial art of Tamil Nadu. "Silambal" is a word generally used to denote the sound created by the swinging of the long staff. Thus Silambam became the popular word to describe the martial art that used long staff. As and when some inimical humans attacked them with sticks, they had to defend themselves with sticks. Thus a kind of fighting with sticks began to develop.

The length of the staff depends on the height of the practitioner. Ideally, it should just touch the forehead about three fingers from the head, typically measuring around 1.68 metres (five and a half feet).

Over the period rules and regulations were framed for Silambam and so it developed into a martial sport. There are state, national, continental and International Federations are formed for silambam and annual competitions are being held as per norms.
