DATE OF PROJECT DAY: 16th and 17th December 2022

Teachers will be guiding children to boost their self-confidence. Children are also required to do the scrap book at home and worksheets at school with the guidance of teacher as part of the learning process for the Project Day .

General instructions:

- Details of topics, activities, and time slot for each student will be uploaded in Parent app e- content on 21.11.2022
- Students will complete their scrap book and worksheet in the classroom under the supervision of the teacher.

- > Students should wear school uniform (Blue track pants and RedT-shirt) during the Project Day
- > Students who are participating in cultural activities will be in their respective costumes.
- Each student will be given 2-3 minutes to talk on the given topic.
- Students are expected to prepare a model or a chart on the topic given. Making models out of plastics and thermocol is not permitted. School will not accept projects made out of thermocol.

Guidelines for Scrap book and Worksheets:

- Students will complete the scrapbook at home (Class VI-VIII) and worksheets at school during class time.
- Scrapbook content will be written in the 40pgs unruled book issued during book-sale.
- Cover page Own creativity of the students based on the theme
- > Page 1 Student name, class, section and theme with basic decoration by student.
- > Page 2 & 3 Index, Sl. No Topic/ Subject description/Particular Page No.
- Page 4 onwards relevant pictures of the topic should be pasted on the left side and content on the right side

Order of the subjects in the scrapbook is as follows:

- 2. Maths
- 3. EVS
- 4. Social Studies
- 5. L2
- 6. L3
- 7. Computer Science
- 8. Art and Craft
- 9. PT

Each subject has 2 topics

Worksheets will be shared in the classroom. Subject teachers will discuss the worksheets in the class and help children to complete them during class hours.
