## TOY PEDAGOGY-MONTESSORI TOYS

Childhood is the stage of our life in which the smallest of things gives immense pleasure. Children often learn many concepts and skills while engaging in play activities. Toy-based pedagogy is based on the principle that toys are not just for entertainment or recreation but can also be used as a learning resource for the child's mental, physical, social, and emotional development. Toy-based learning comes under the broad gamut of Play-based Learning.

# SKILL DEVELOPMENT

## BUTTONING THE SHIRT – 13.12.2023

Buttoning is a fun fine motor skill to work on. This activity promotes fine motor and self-care skills like dressing. The ability to button and manipulate clothes fasteners is an important skill for kids to master to help them achieve independence with dressing. Learning to do up their buttons and zippers can be tricky as a range of fine motor skills are required to complete these types of tasks.



# SKILL DEVELOPMENT

## THREADING THE BEADS – 14.12.2023

Threading beads can help to strengthen the small muscles in children's hands as they grasp different-sized beads. They will use various hand movements. Using a bead tray to store your children's beads provides even more opportunities to improve their fine motor skills. Reaching for a bead, picking up a bead, and then rotating the bead to thread it all use different hand movements. The benefit of developing fine motor skills through threading beads is that it uses similar hand movements to gripping.



# ART AND CRAFT - DRAWING

EAR BUD ART - 18.12.2023

Cotton bud painting is a wonderful way to help develop your child's fine motor skills. The fine pincer grip required to hold the earbuds in place and move them around the paper to paint is ideal for building the smaller muscles of the hand. This activity is also a great way to practice fine motor skills and grasp. The precision you use to create pictures using small dots is wonderful motor control practice for young children.



# ART AND CRAFT - MOBILES

## Princess cup Dressup/Hot air Balloon - 19.12.2023

This activity helps the children to explore and gives a sense of achievement. Based on the theme "Toy- pedagogy" children made a "Princess dress up cup and hot air balloon" mobile. They enjoyed sticking and playing in hot air balloons and Princess. It made the children more imaginative and creative and also helped them to develop fine motor skills.



# ART AND CRAFT – 20.12.23

## Project Day Take Home - Frog Shooting Tongue

Children at nursery school do so much of crafts. The experts say that this activity is essential for the development of children. When doing the craft, children have to use their fingers actively and use both hands simultaneously, which develops their fine motor skills and bilateral coordination skills. These skills allow children to do everything on their own without assistance from parents.

Children were able to do rocking horse with the help of the teacher, they stuck eyes, head, and tail and enjoyed playing with this rocking horse. Children used two paper cups, a small one as the head and a big cup as the body of the Giraffe which has to be stuck to the paper folding neck and legs. Children stuck the skin pattern (brown spots) on the large cups and eyes in the small cups and helped the teacher finish the other parts. On the whole, children enjoyed and learned to make the craft with other friends.
