- Close unwanted applications on your computer to optimize the video quality.
- All doubts will be clarified at the end of the session using Chat .
- Keep paper and a pen or pencil or learning materials handy to take notes as instructed in the schedule.
- Remember to sign out or "leave the meeting" when the session is finished.
- In case if the students miss the session due to technical fault they can view the videos uploaded in youtube by our teachers and learn the concept.

## **ACADEMICS:**

### **Classwork:**

#### **March and April Month Portions:**

Students are expected to write the classwork in CW notebook. Instructions will be sent as HW message on daily basis. Softcopy of the notes of Lesson of June month portions will be shared soon. Extra classes will be given to Mathematics to workout more problems and to discuss the answers of homework and worksheets.

Homework will be send regularly as per schedule on daily basis. Students are expected to complete the homework as per the schedule.

Softcopy is already shared as econtent. Answers will be discussed by teachers during revision time.

#### **June Month:**

Worksheets for June month will be send as send as softcopy. Teachers will discuss the answers after completing each chapter.
