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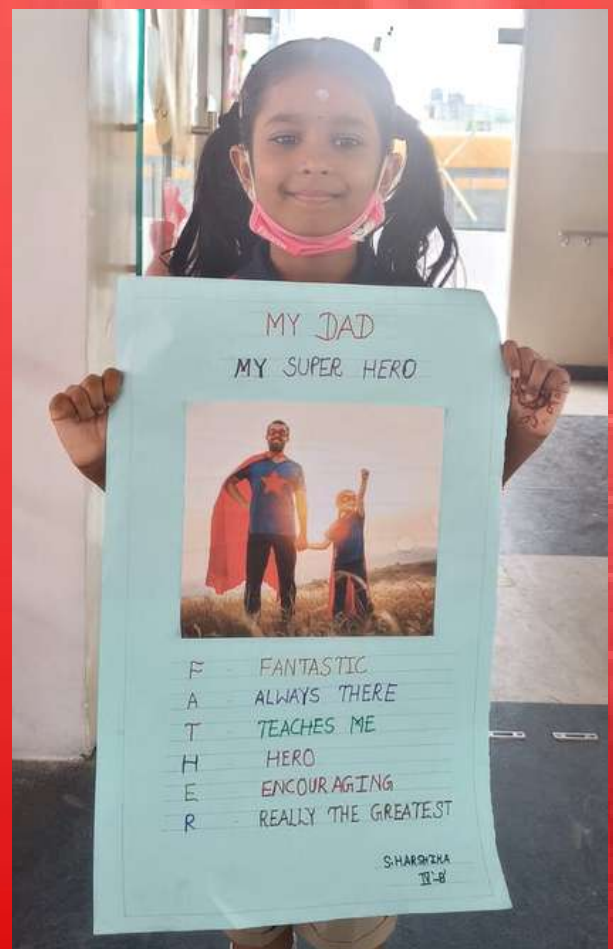


ASSEMBLY

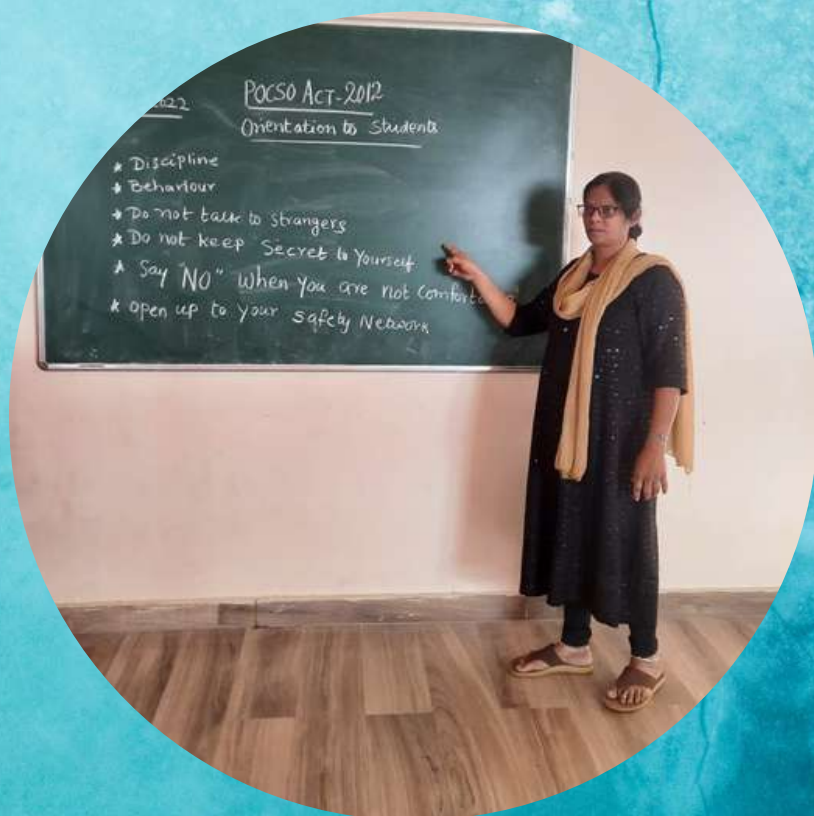
POCSO ACT 2012

It was an interesting and a thrilling experience for the kids sharing their feelings with peer which provided fun and comfortable learning arena for everyone involved.





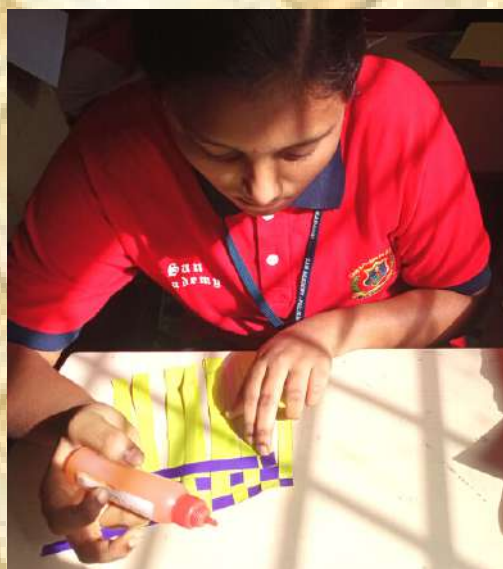
CLUB ACTIVITY

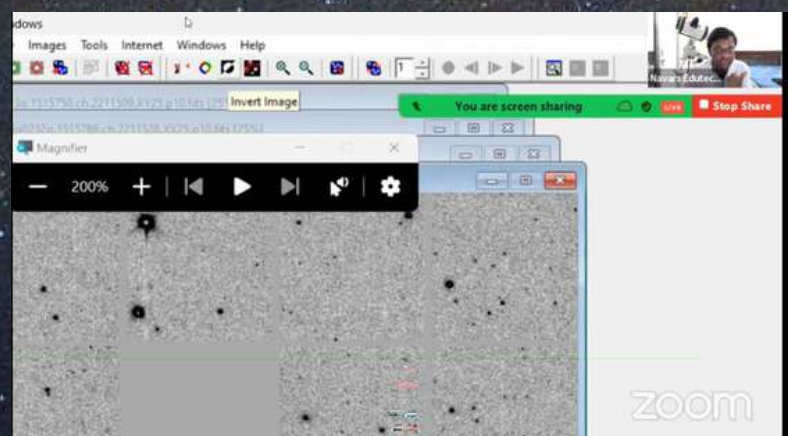
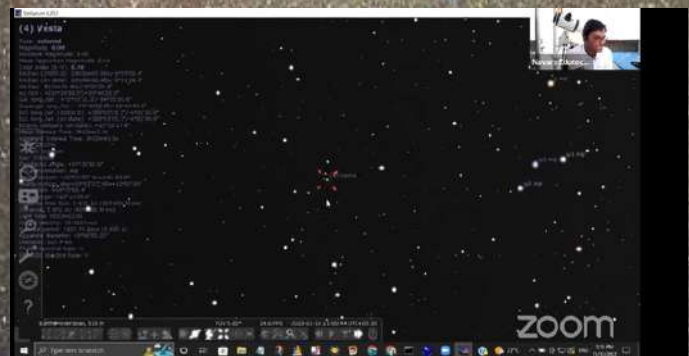


NASO VIRTUAL SESSION

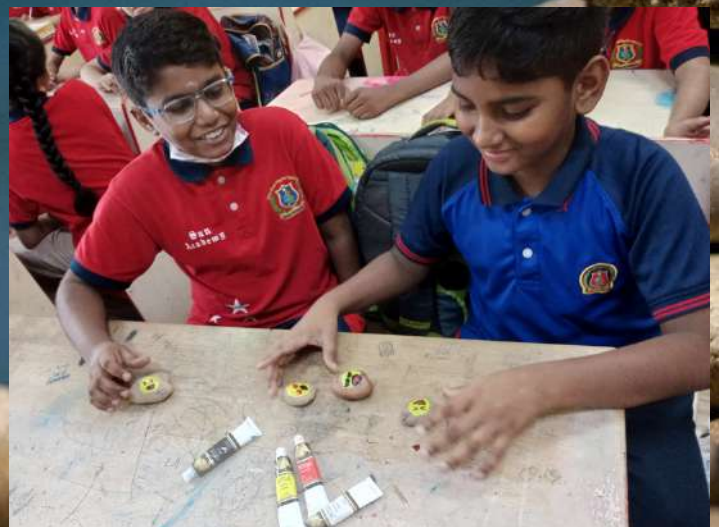
Children from grade III – V enthusiastically participated and enjoyed making beautiful and creative jewellery like necklace, bangles, earrings, bindis

JEWELLERY MAKING

Jewellery making is the process of creating ornamental pieces worn for personal decoration or adornment. The materials can range from stone to precious metals, and the techniques are versatile and limitless. Various types of jewellery making incorporate different skills in children.

Students of class III to V made different jewellery using origami paper, beads and artificial flowers. Beaded jewellery is the art or craft of attaching beads by stringing them with a needle and thread or thin wire. Beads used in jewellery are small pieces of plastic, glass, gemstones, or wood, typically round in shape, with a hole in the centre for threading.

Arts and crafts are perfect for helping children to develop skills across a range of developmental areas. Young children learn and acquire new skills at a remarkable pace, as they learn how to navigate and interact with the world around them. As they play and explore, children are constantly developing their motor, cognitive, and social skills, all of which will aid them throughout their lives as they go on to study, work, and form relationships with others.

for the previous two classes learned how to fix a nail and how to drill. So today class participated very enthusiastically in making the key holder.

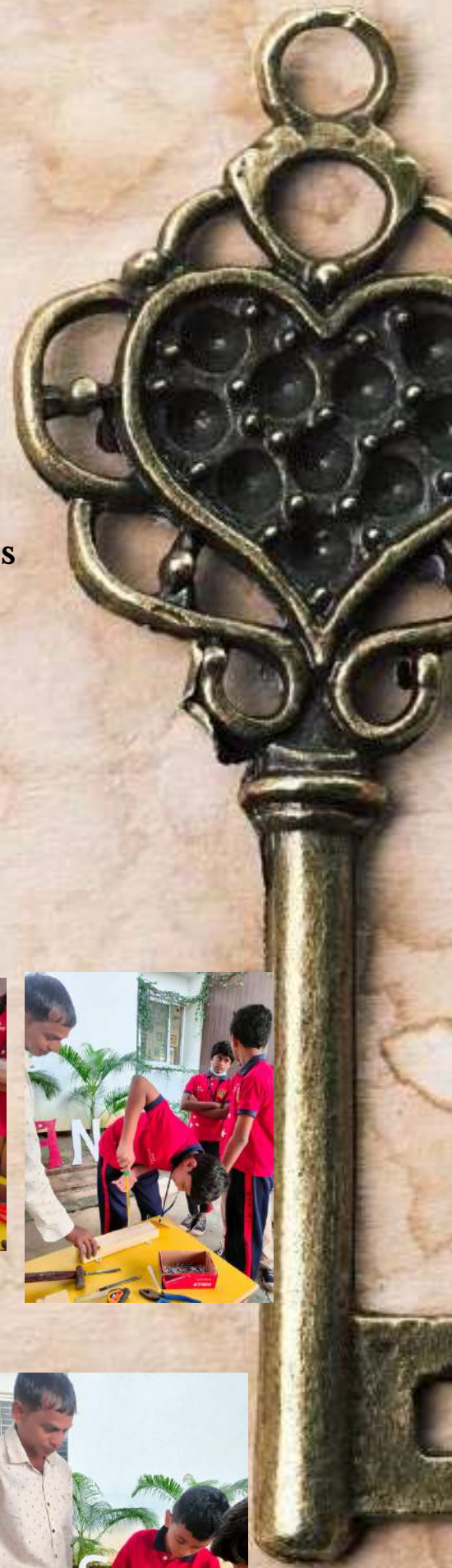
They measured the wood and marked.

Then they fixed the key hold lplate.

They nailed the hooks. All the students were given chance to fix one hook in the key holder. In order to fix the hooks first they screwed a nail, then removed it then fixed the "j" hooks. Key holder is now ready.

Materials used: wooden plank, key holder plates, j hooks.

Tools used: measuring tapes, hammer, star screw driver, jumper.



HORTICULTURE

Students of grade 6 to 8 who has opted horticulture were enthusiastically gathered in the garden with teachers for No bag day activity. Gardener Shankar was ready to explain the students about types of manure used in the garden and garden maintenance.

Students learnt various types of manure like aloe vera gel, cow dung, goat dung, vegetable waste, coconut shell grinded with curd and panchakayam which is made by cow products.

Then students learnt the ways to protect and remove insects from plants. As ants carry insects to the plant because of the sweetness in the plant. It can be removed by spraying neem oil or by grinding ginger with cumin seeds and mixing with water.

Finally they learnt to replant the plant by using their stem with the help of aloe vera gel. Then students went for the garden visit and saw various plants like alla, veld grape, hibiscus and marigold.

Students had a very informative session.



FOOD PROCESSING

Students of grade 6-8 from all the sections were taken to Modern Bakery Pvt Ltd, Madhavaram on field trip as a part of Food processing No bag day activity on 19.11.22 Children learn about the production of biscuits and chocolates.

They learnt about the quality checking, mixing, packing and transportation process of biscuits.

26.11.2022

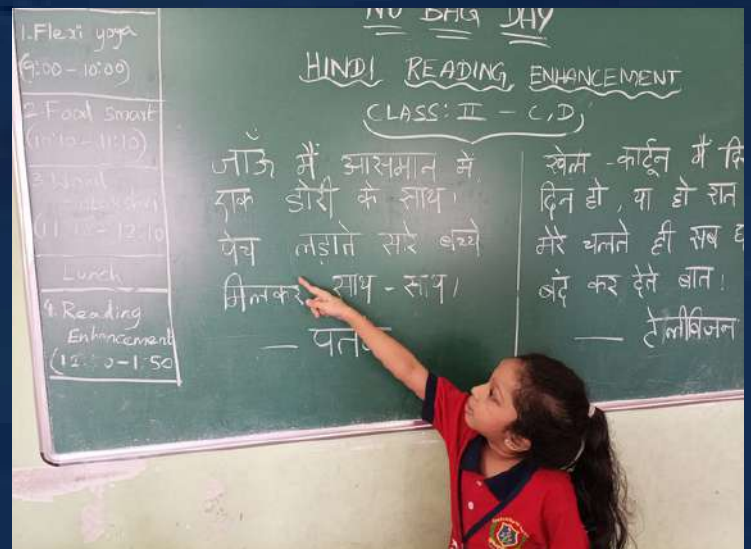


Topic : Food smart
