22.09.2022


Assembly is conducted on 22/9/22 for Class 3 A on the topic "World car-free day". Assembly started with the prayer Tamizh thai yazhthu.

The students will be presenting their topic according to the given time slot.





It was a delight to hear them talk about the traditional games, bat and ball game, water sports and adventure games










IEO EXAMINATION 22.9.2022


Students express gratitude
