CLUB ACTIVITY

Theme: Origami Wonders

Activity: Paper Magic – House Origami

Category: Individual



Date: 08.01.2026 and 29.01.2026

Aim : To boost concentration, creativity, and geometry skills with hands-on origami.

Materials required: Craft Paper, Pencils, Colour Pencils.

Procedure :

- Step 1: Start with a square-shaped colourful origami paper. Place the coloured side down.
- Step 2: Fold the paper in two halves by bringing the left edge over the right edge. Open the fold.
- Step 3: Fold it again into two halves horizontally by placing the top edge over the bottom. Unfold it.
- Step 4: Considering the top half as one, fold it like step 3. Turn the paper over. Repeat the same for the bottom half. This will create four equal horizontal divisions on the paper.
- Step 5: Fold the left edge and right edge to the centre of the paper.
- Step 6: Now open the top left and right flaps and spread each corner to either side. Flatten them down such that it takes the shape of the roof. This part might be a bit tricky.
- Step 7: Turn the entire figure over and draw doors and windows using a marker. Finally, your desired house origami is built.

Learning Outcomes :

- Creating and practising different step-by-step origami shapes and patterns help develop children's imagination
- Enhance their colour sense and artistic skills.
- It also helps children to concentrate and improve spatial awareness.
- Develops sequencing and fine motor skills.

Skills they develop:

Fine motor skill, Concentration and focus, spatial awareness and sequencing.

Theme: *Kindness*

Activity: Make a card

Category: Individual

Date: 08.01.2026 and 29.01.2026

Aim : To help students express kindness and positive feelings through creative card making.

Materials required:

- Coloured paper / chart paper / cut outs
- Crayons / colour pencils / sketch pens
- Glue
- Scissors (child-safe)
- Stickers / glitter (optional)

Procedure:

- The teacher explains the theme about kindness using simple examples and through stories.
- Students by folding a coloured paper.
- They colour and cut a simple shape (heart, sun, or flower), or they draw or decorate pictures related to kindness.
- A small paper strip is folded and pasted to make the shape pop out inside the card.
- Students write a short kind message inside the card.

Learning Outcomes :

- Expressing feelings through art and words
- Develops creativity and imagination
- Encourages kindness and empathy (Use polite words in daily conversation)
- Improves fine motor skills
- Builds confidence and self-expression
