**Activity:** Classroom organization and cleanliness,  
Promoting teamwork and cooperation  
Reducing noise or distractions in class.

**Category:** Individual

**Date:** 07.01.2026 and 28.01.2026

**Aim :** To encourage students to think critically and creatively to propose practical solutions for common classroom or school-related challenges.

#### **Materials required:**

- Chart paper
- Markers, pens, pencils, or coloured pens
- Sticky notes, cards, or small sheets for captions
- Decorative items (optional)

#### **Procedure:**

- Identify a common classroom problem or challenge (e.g., organization, teamwork, cleanliness).
- Brainstorm creative solutions individually. Have interactive group discussions
- Brainstorm multiple creative solutions individually and use short, catchy phrases or word puzzles to communicate your solution.(Use rhymes, alliteration, or wordplay)
- Design a display on chart paper with a clear caption describing the solution.
- Decorate and arrange the display to make it visually appealing.
- Present your idea to teachers or peers if required.

**Aim :** To encourage students to express their thoughts, feelings, and ideas creatively through journal writing.

#### **Materials required:**

- A4 sheets ,Coloured or scrap paper
- Sketch pens, crayons, colour pencils, Old magazines/ Newspapers (optional)
- Glue, scissors, ruler.

#### **Procedure:**

- The teacher introduces the activity by sharing a brief success story of Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam to inspire the students.
- The teacher guides and assists the students in writing a short journal entry about Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam, highlighting his values and achievements.
- Students may also relate the topic to their own experiences, classroom life, or personal values.
