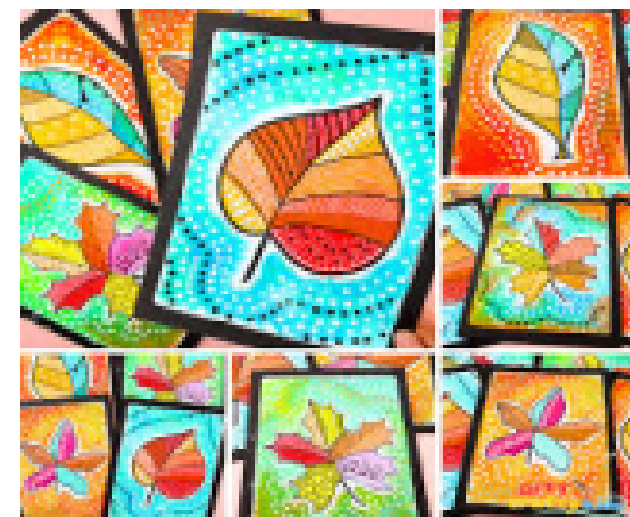

Activity: Art related Colour Splash

Category : Individual

Date: 09.01.2026 and 30.01.2026



Aim:

To encourage creativity, improve colour sense, and help students express their ideas through art.

Materials Required:

- Drawing sheets
- Water colours / poster colours
- Paint brushes / old toothbrush
- Palette
- Water cups
- Apron or old newspaper

Procedure:

- Spread newspaper on the table to avoid mess.
- Give each student a drawing sheet.
- Ask students to choose colours of their choice.
- Dip the brush/toothbrush in paint and gently splash or spread colours on the paper.
- Allow students to blend colours and create patterns or pictures.
- Let the artwork dry and display it in the classroom.

Learning Outcome:

- Students develop creativity, imagination, colour recognition, and fine motor skills.
- They also gain confidence in expressing themselves through art.

Category: Individual

Date: 21.01.2026

Aim:

To encourage creativity and imagination in students by using thumb impressions as a unique art form, while developing fine motor skills, originality, and confidence in self-expression through art and colours.

SUGGESTED TOPICS: Nature and Environment, Festivals of India, My Dream World.

Materials required:

- Drawing sheet (A4 size)
- Poster colours / water colours
- Ink pads (safe and non-toxic)
- Wet wipes / tissue paper
- Apron or old newspaper

Criteria for Judgement:

- Creativity and concept -- 5 marks
- Technic and craftsmanship -- 5 marks
- Composition and use of space -- 5 marks
- Attention to Precision -- 5 marks

Rules and Regulations:

- Participants must complete the artwork within the given time.
- No external assistance is permitted.
- The artwork must be neat and clean.
- Each participant can submit only one entry.

Aim:

Materials Required:

- Create the poster neatly, ensuring a clear message and attractive visuals.
- Submit or display the poster as instructed

- No external assistance will be allowed.
- Students must adhere strictly to the given time limit.
- Content should be appropriate and relevant to the topic.
- Word limit – 500 words
