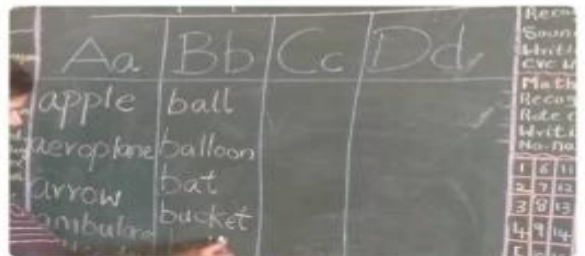


Language Development
