NO BAG DAY CLASS 6-8

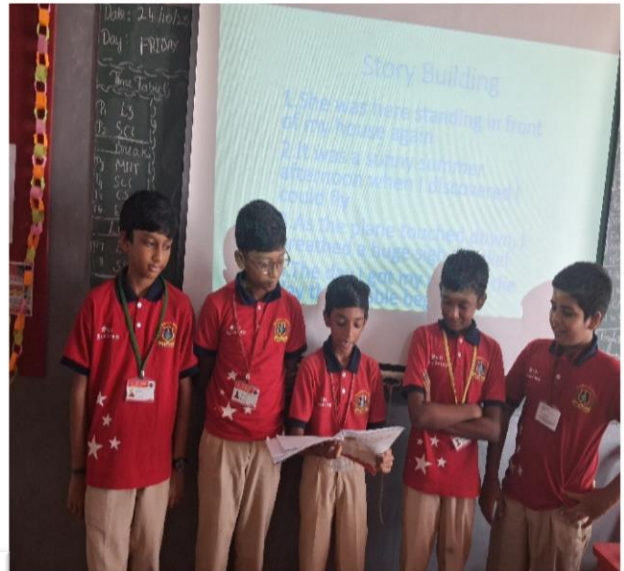
