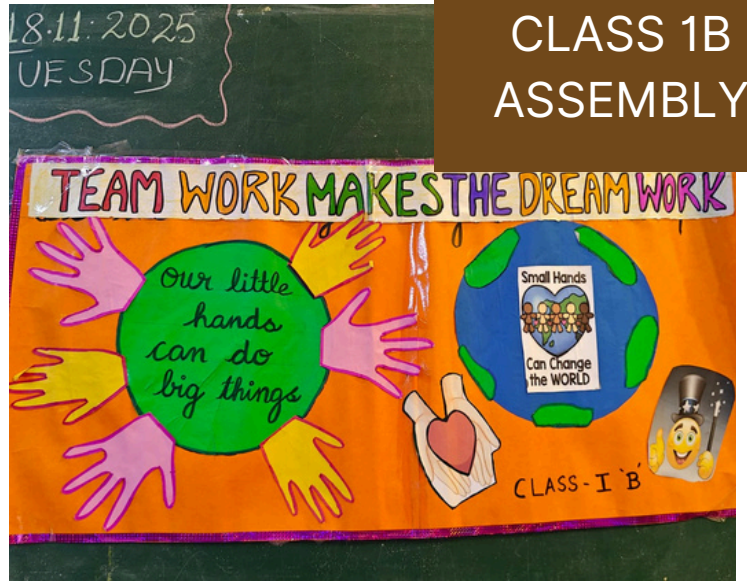

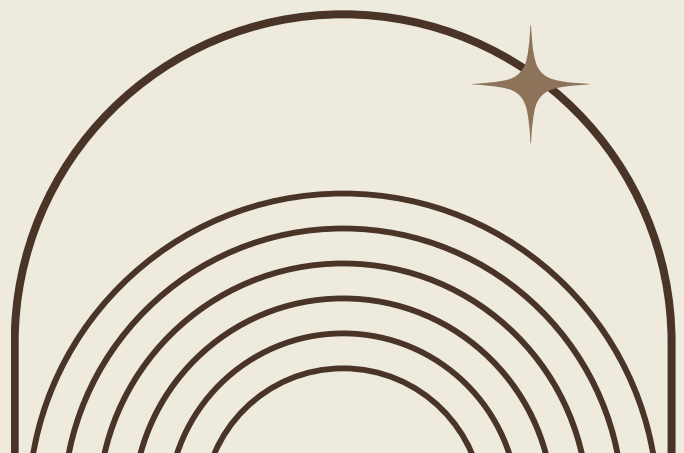


GURUNAKA JAYANTHI

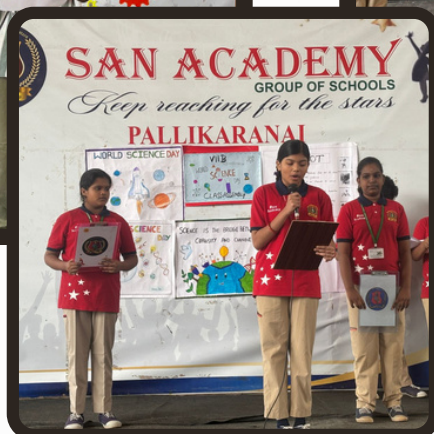

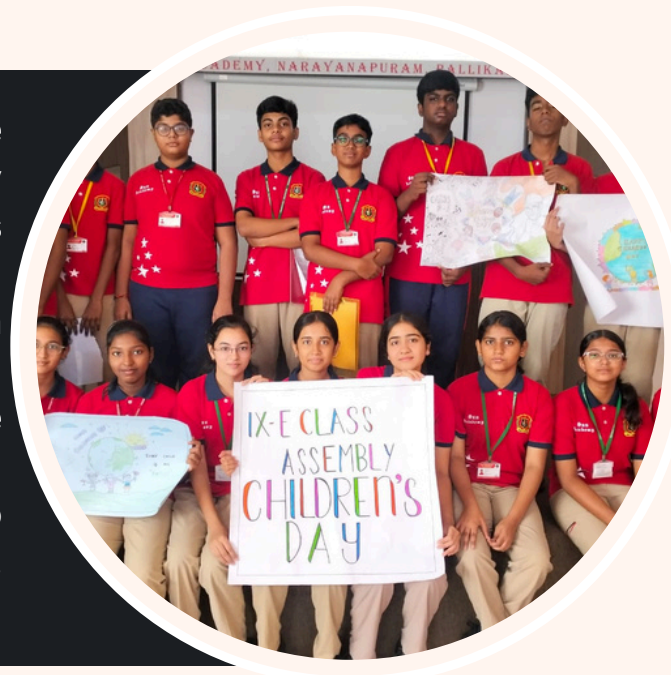

CLASS X B

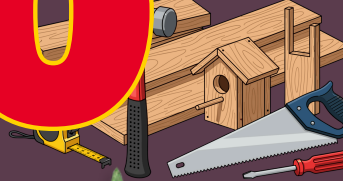

A POCSO orientation meeting was held on 28 November 2025, facilitated by the Principal, Ms. Hemalatha Sooryanarayanan. The committee reviewed the POCSO activities conducted during November, addressed safety and campus conduct concerns, and emphasized professionalism among staff. Plans were also made for student awareness sessions on hygiene and behavioural guidance to promote a safe and supportive school environment.



POCSO ORIENTATION FOR CLASS I & II TEACHERS SAN PALLIKARANAI

A POCSO orientation session was conducted on 26 November 2025 by the school counsellor, Ms. Mohana Priya J, to familiarise Class I and II teachers with essential child-protection practices. The session covered key provisions and recent updates of the POCSO Act, introduced the e-POCSO court system, and included a self-awareness activity to help teachers reflect on their responses and better support young learners.



UNIFIED INCLUSIVE SPORTS EXPERIENCE

On 22 November, Psychology students from San Academy, Pallikaranai participated in a unified inclusive sports event for individuals with intellectual disabilities at Montfort School as part of their voluntary service learning. MORAL INSTRUCTION SESSIONS FOR CLASSES VII, VIII & IX

Special moral instruction sessions were conducted for students of Classes VII to IX to promote health awareness, self-understanding, and responsible behaviour.

For girls, a menstrual hygiene awareness session was led by Dr. Sanjana Satyamurthy (Plush), covering body basics, the menstrual cycle, hygiene practices, comfort measures, and myth-busting discussions, followed by an interactive Q&A.

For boys, a session on Self and Adolescence was conducted by the school counsellor, Ms. Mohana Priya J, focusing on physical, emotional, social, and cognitive changes during adolescence, while emphasizing safety, healthy boundaries, positive relationships, and self-awareness.

STUDENTS ACHIVEMENTS 2025-26



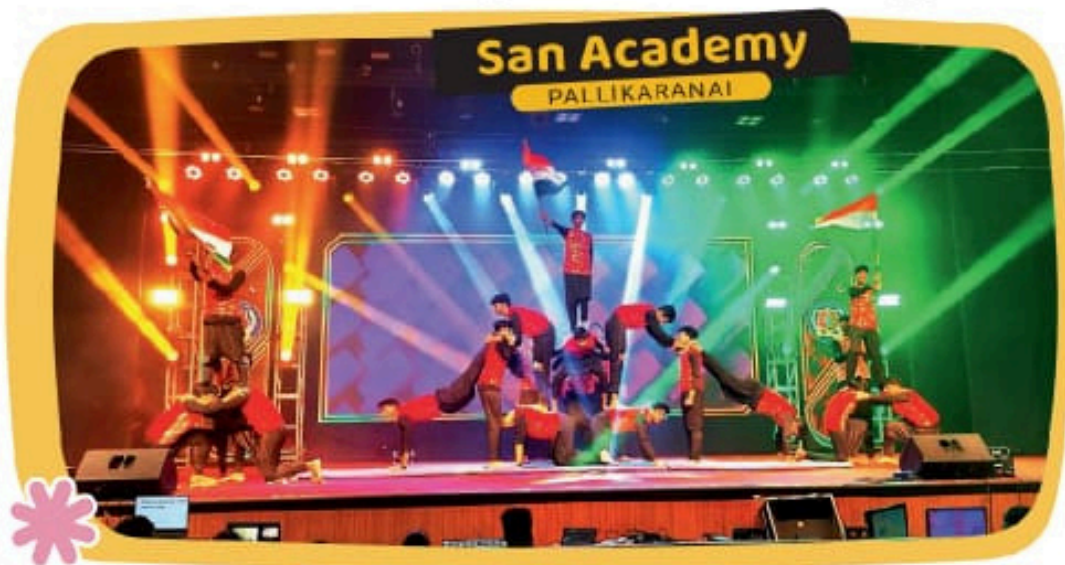
