SCOUTS ADVENTURE CAMP

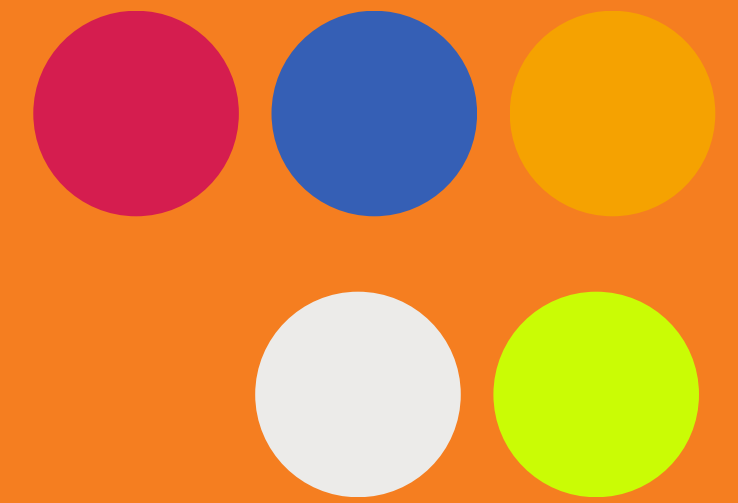


Scouts Adventure Camp – Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh

BUILDING SELF-CONFIDENCE

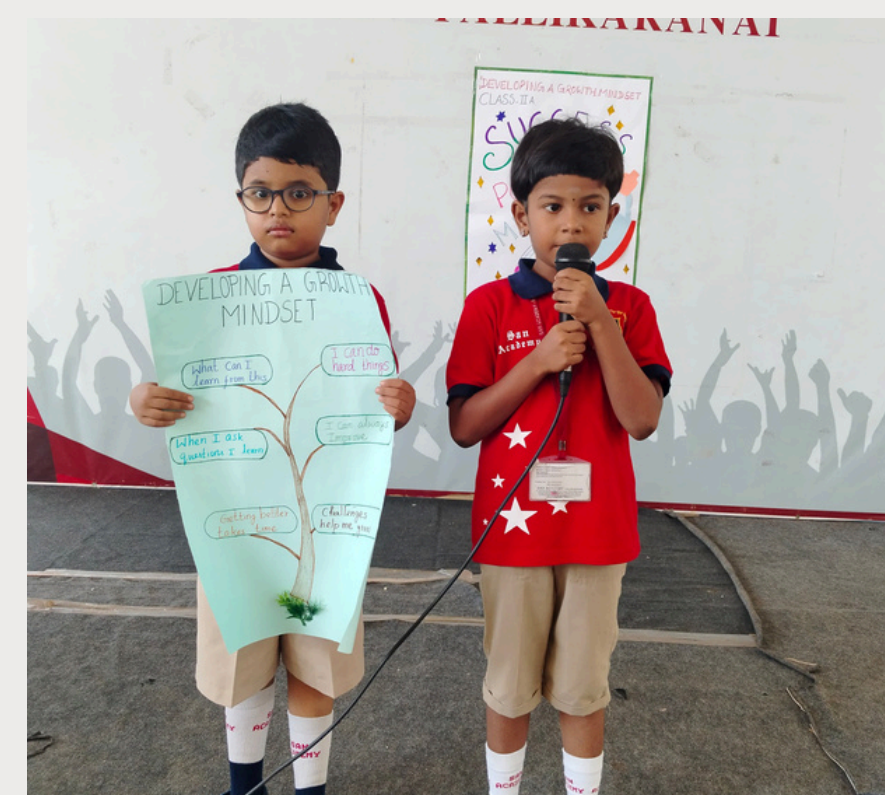
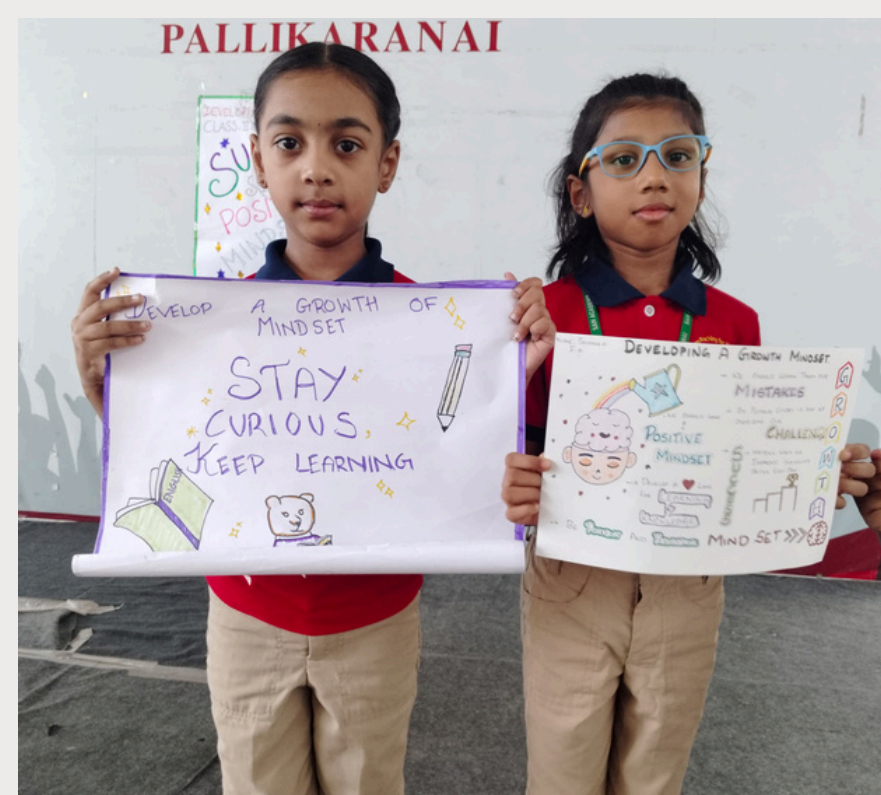

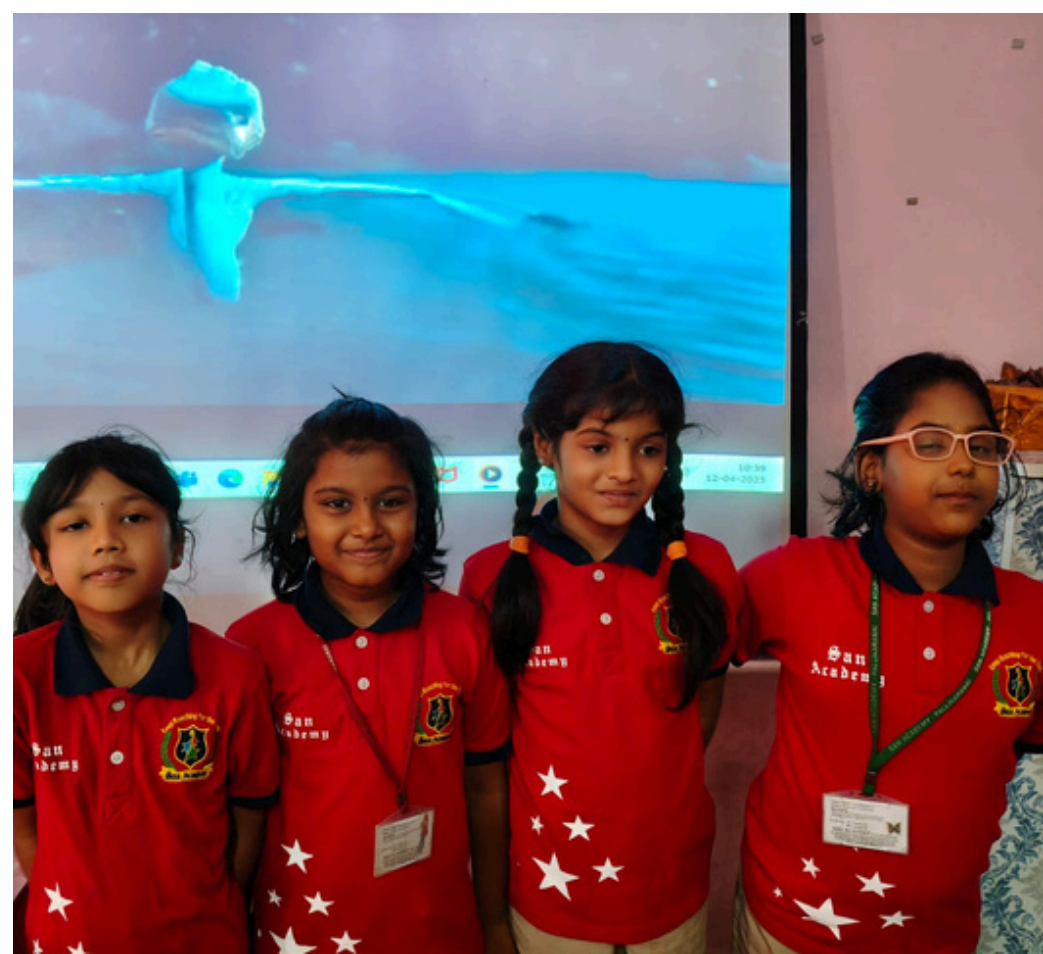


With powerful messages and thought-provoking performances, this assembly encouraged students to dream big and stay committed to their goals, despite distractions or setbacks.

POCSO COMMITTEE MEETING

On April 24, 2025, from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM, a POCSO Committee meeting was held in the Sr. KG C classroom, attended by parent committee members and school staff. The session commenced with expressions of appreciation from the parent committee members towards all teachers for their dedication, excellence in subject delivery, and effective student management.

The committee emphasized the importance of encouraging more after-school activities to foster holistic student development. To enhance communication and feedback, suggestion boxes have been installed in both school buildings.

They also advocated for the introduction of menstrual health education for students in Classes 4 to 8 to promote awareness and hygiene. In line with this, incinerators have been installed in girls' restrooms to ensure proper sanitary disposal.

Additionally, the committee discussed implementing rainwater harvesting systems in the school's front area to prevent water clogging and promote environmental sustainability.

The meeting concluded with a shared commitment to continually monitor and enhance student safety, hygiene, and overall development.



POCSO

Orientation for Drivers & Attenders

An orientation session on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act was held on April 25, 2025, from 10:30 to 11:00 AM in the 1A classroom, for drivers and attenders. The session aimed to enhance their understanding of child safety and their responsibilities in maintaining a secure school environment.

The session began with a discussion on the importance of using appropriate verbal and body language, both on and off-campus, to maintain professionalism. A segment on personality development and self-grooming followed, highlighting how appearance and behavior influence self-confidence and serve as positive examples for students.

The orientation emphasized adopting a positive, respectful approach, showcasing kindness, compassion, and a growth mindset to build trust with students. A key discussion topic was gender sensitivity, stressing the need to treat all individuals with equality and respect.

The responsibilities of drivers and attenders were outlined clearly, highlighting their vital role in student safety during transportation. Attendees were reminded of the importance of vigilance and their proactive role in safeguarding children.

The session concluded with a strong commitment to upholding the discussed principles and contributing to a safe, inclusive, and supportive school environment.



POCSO ORIENTATION FOR CLASS XII STUDENT

In the second week of April 2025, a moral instruction session was conducted for Class XII students in their respective classrooms. The session addressed critical societal issues and aimed to encourage responsible and informed behavior.

The session opened with a discussion on juvenile delinquency, its causes, and the role of positive influences, family support, and community involvement in prevention.

An overview of anti-drug abuse campaigns was presented, emphasizing the harmful effects of substance abuse and promoting awareness and healthy lifestyle choices among students.

The topic of sexual offenses was also addressed, focusing on understanding consent, respecting boundaries, and recognizing the legal implications of inappropriate behavior. Students were urged to foster mutual respect and to report any concerning behavior.

The concept of cognitive dissonance was introduced, explaining the psychological discomfort caused by conflicting beliefs and behaviors. Students were guided on how to manage and resolve these conflicts for emotional and mental well-being.

The session concluded with a discussion on community engagement, encouraging students to take part in social initiatives and community service, which contribute to personal growth and social responsibility.

The session aimed to equip students with the awareness and tools needed to navigate complex social challenges and become proactive, responsible members of society.



POCSO ORIENTATION FOR

Class 1 & 2 Teachers

On April 26, 2025, from 9:15 to 9:45 AM, an orientation session on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act was conducted for Class 1 and 2 teachers. The session aimed to strengthen their understanding of child protection laws and equip them with strategies to address behavioral challenges.

The session began with an overview of the POCSO Act, focusing on identifying signs of abuse, dispelling myths, and creating a safe space for student disclosure. Teachers were also briefed on available support systems and reporting procedures.

A review of the previous year's initiatives helped assess progress and highlight areas for improvement.
