



CLASS XII CHANGE THE WORLD




MARCH 22, 2025

The assembly concluded with a pledge for gender equality and respect for all, followed by the National Anthem. The event left the audience motivated to support and uplift the women in their lives.








PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT
