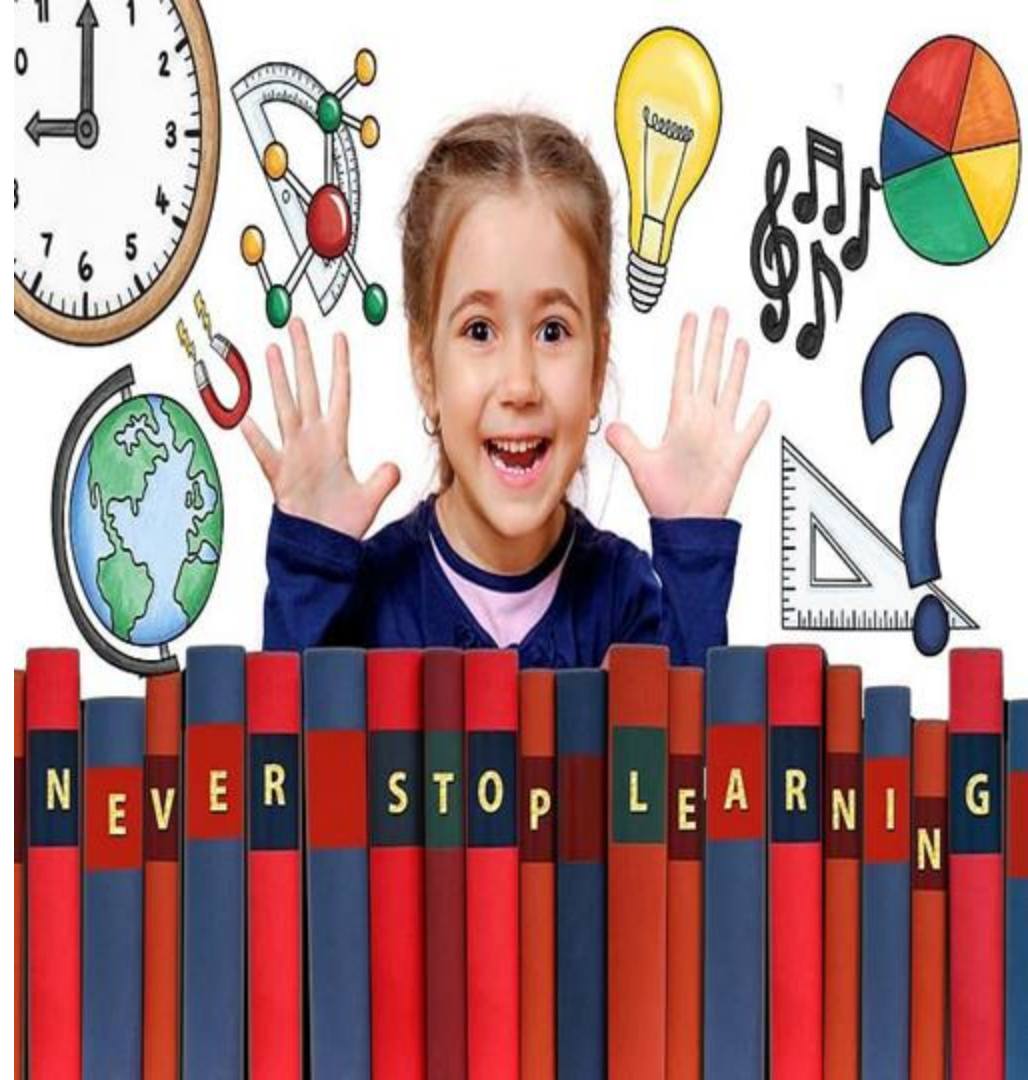


Jr KG & Sr KG - A Happy Start to the New Academic Year – **25.03.2026**
