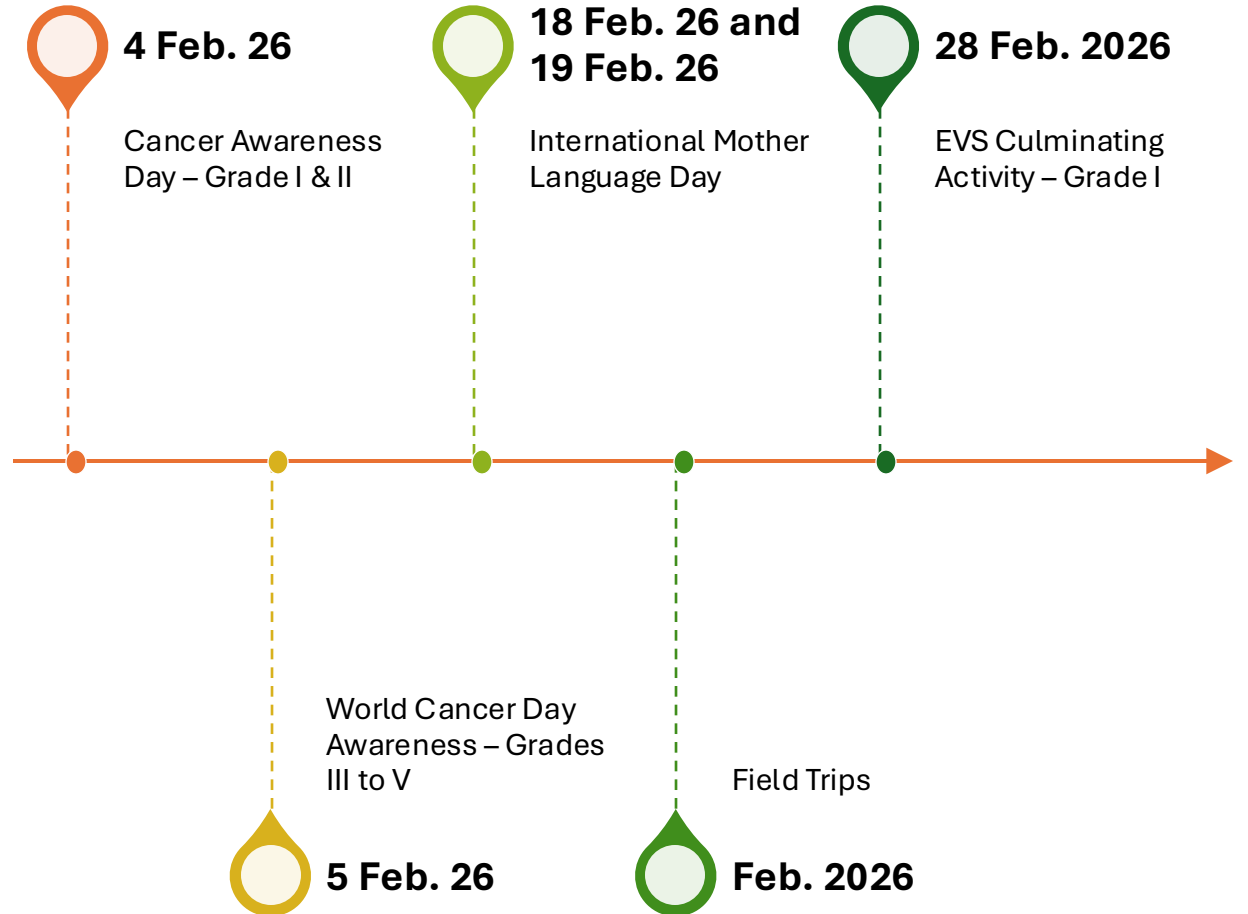
General Class – Jr KG & Sr KG (28.02.26)

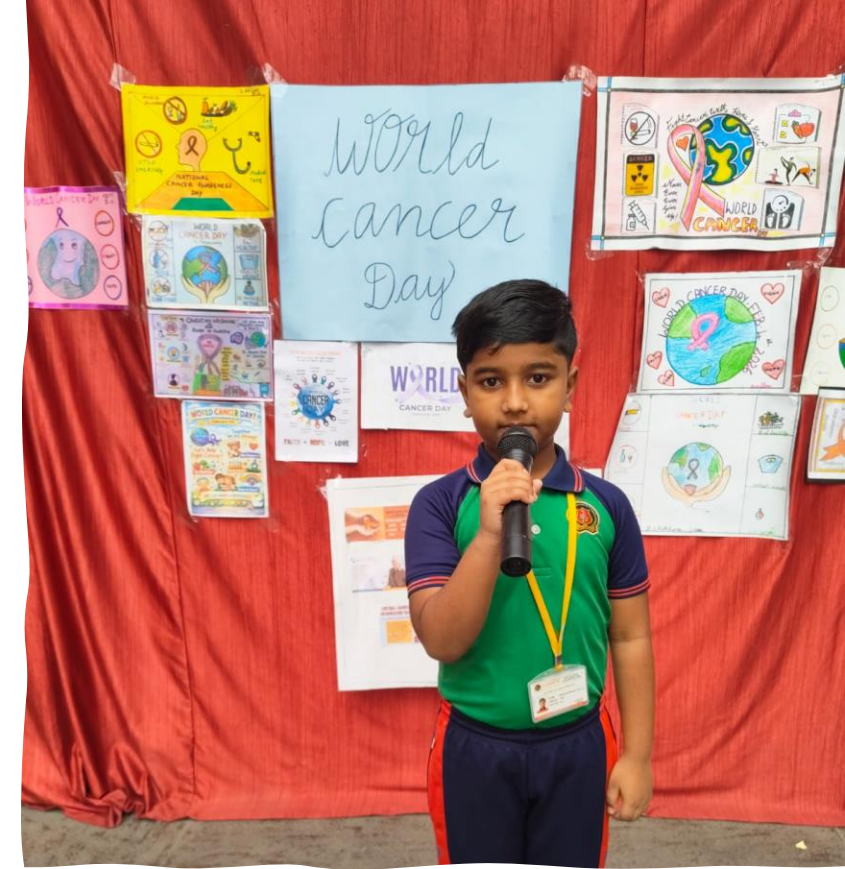
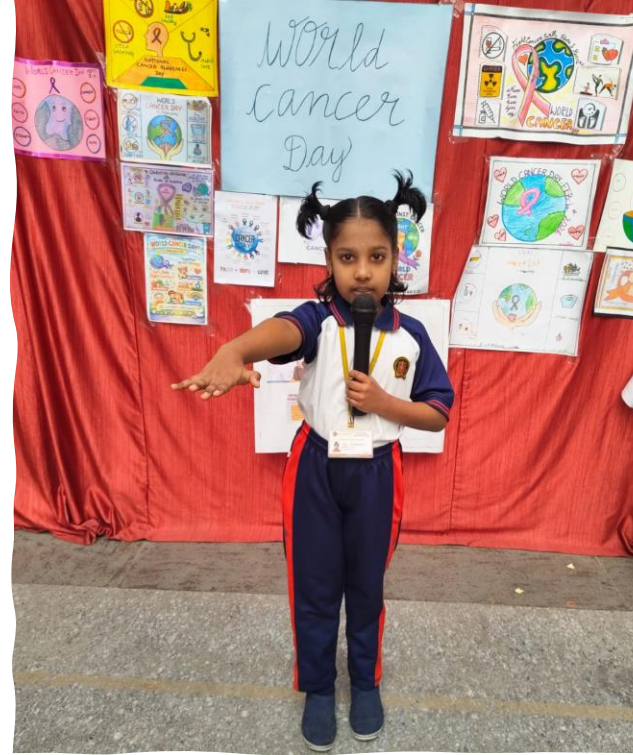


PRIMARY SCHOOL

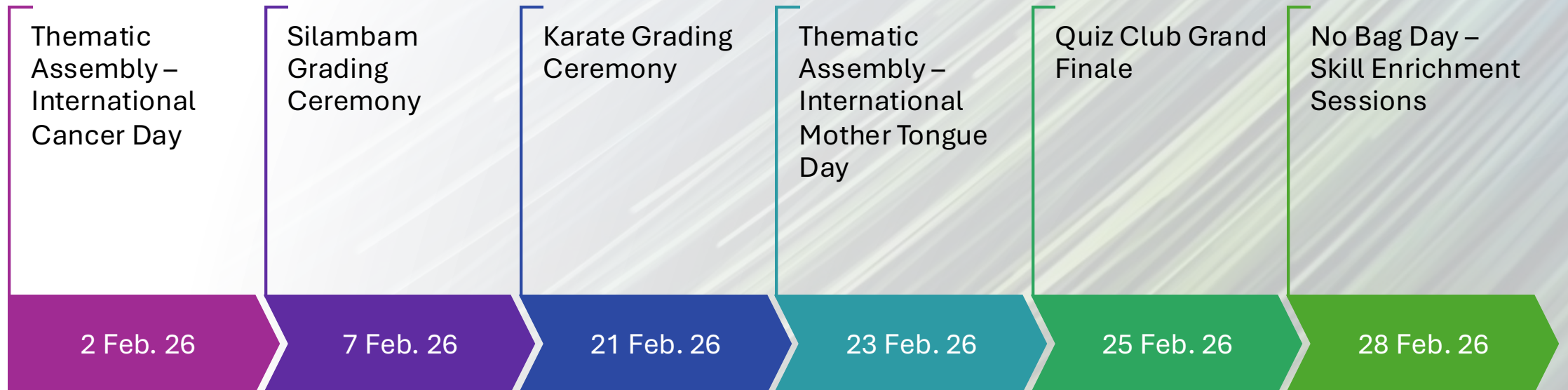


EVS Culminating Activity – Grade I (28.02.2026)

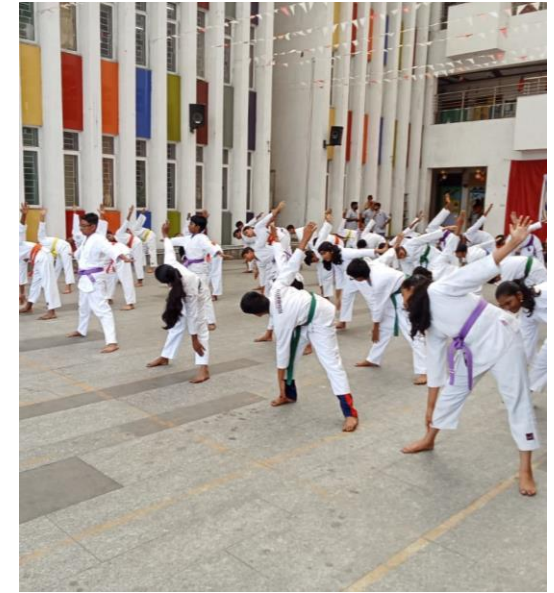




Silambam Grading Ceremony : 7.2.26

Thematic Assembly – International Mother Tongue Day : 23.2.26

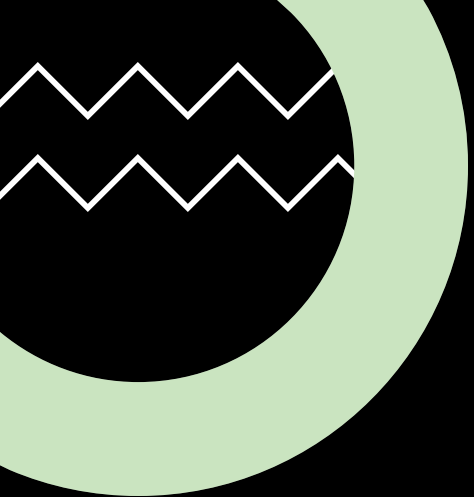

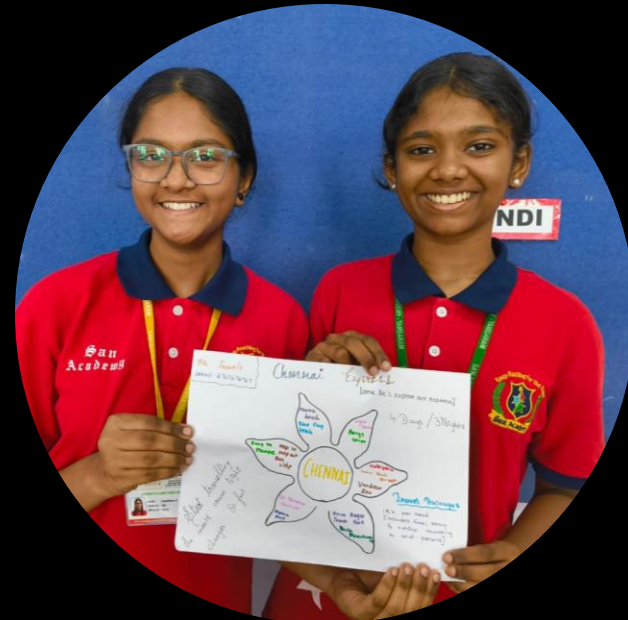
Quiz Club Grand Finale : 25.2.26

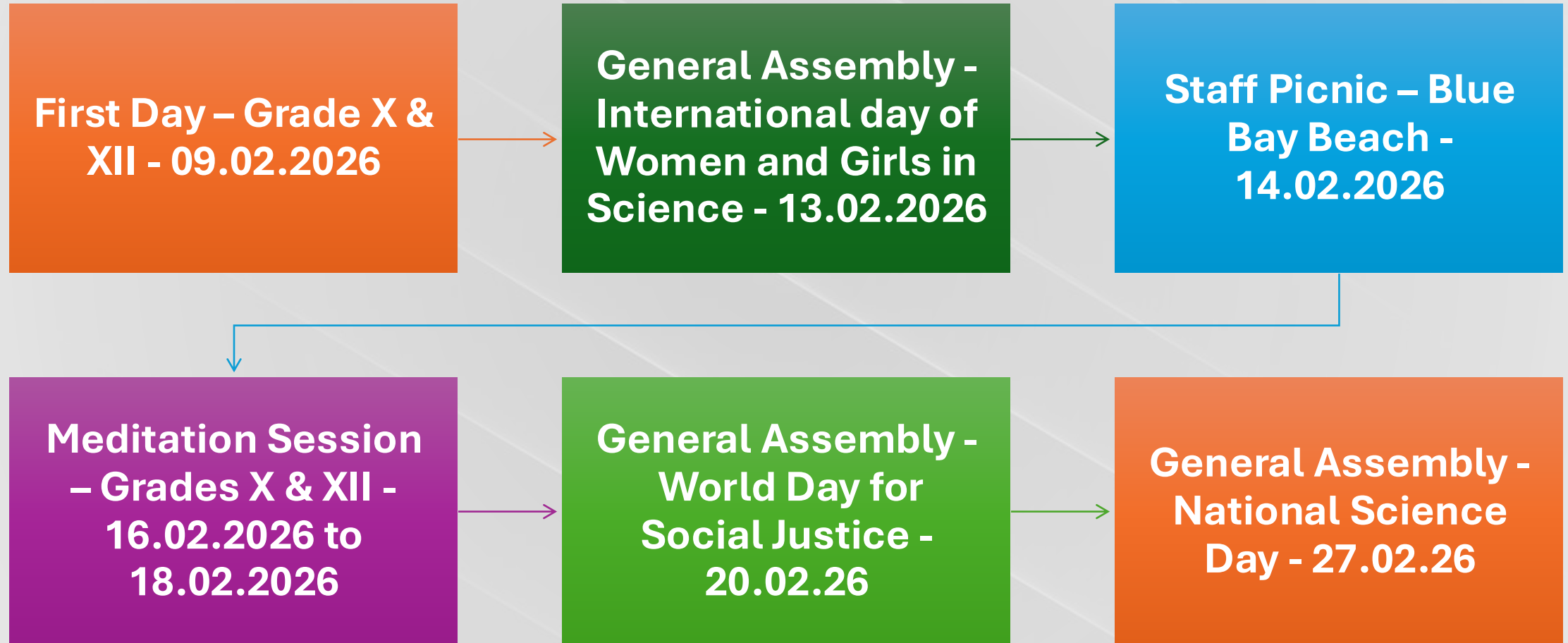


No Bag Day – Skill Enrichment Sessions : 28.2.26

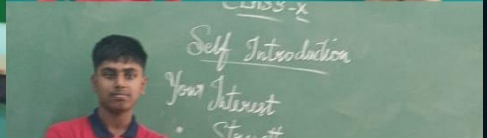

Staff Picnic – Blue Bay Beach 14.02.2026

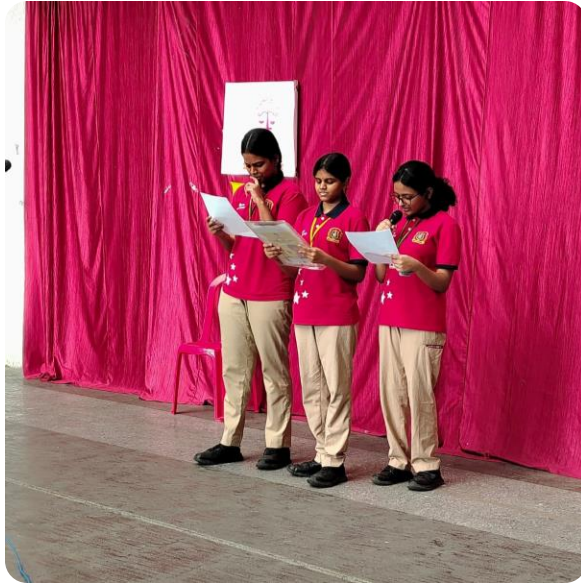
