




Nursery – Show & Tell – 26.11.25


SrKG – Healthy Eating Habits

General Class – JRKG | Aerial Beings

Numeracy skills were strengthened through counting pencils and matching number names with numbers. In phonics, children confidently read CVC words. The interactive session enhanced their cognitive, language, and social skills while making learning fun and engaging.



General Class – SrKG

In their General Class, SrKG children revisited the November theme “**Amphibians, Reptiles, and the Aquatic World.**” Through interactive activities, they identified different animals and learned to differentiate between mammals and aquatic animals. The session helped reinforce concepts, strengthen understanding, and connect learning to their real-world surroundings.



World Kindness Day – 13.11.25






National Pollution Control Day – 27 & 28 Nov

No Bag Day — November 22, 2025




SAFAL Exams for Grade 6 — November 24-26, 2025





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MEDITATION SESSION FOR CLASS 9 - 10.11.2025


SAN QUEST (ROBOTICS EXPO) SAN ACADEMY - PALLIKARANAI - Grades 6-9 on 15.11.2025


FIELDTRIP FOR CLASS 9&11 TO ANNA CENTENARY LIBRARY – 22.11.2025
