# BUNNY SCOUTS PROGRAM – JULY 2025





# GENERAL CLASS – JRKG & SRKG – 31.07.2025



- **JrKG:** The Junior KG students enthusiastically participated in a class based on the theme Community Connect, engaging in a variety of hands-on activities designed to build awareness about community helpers and strengthen foundational skills. Children took part in matching community helpers with the tools they use, helping them understand different roles in society. They also enjoyed sorting objects by color, counting items to develop early math skills, and matching alphabets with names to enhance their language and phonetic awareness. These interactive activities not only made learning fun but also encouraged observation, reasoning, and connection to the world around them.
- **SrKG:** Students from Senior KG participated in a General Class activity based on the theme "Our Body System." # GENERAL ASSEMBLY 4.7.2024 (GRADE - XA)








# PTM 19.7.2025
