Field Trip - Shell Museum - 11.06.26

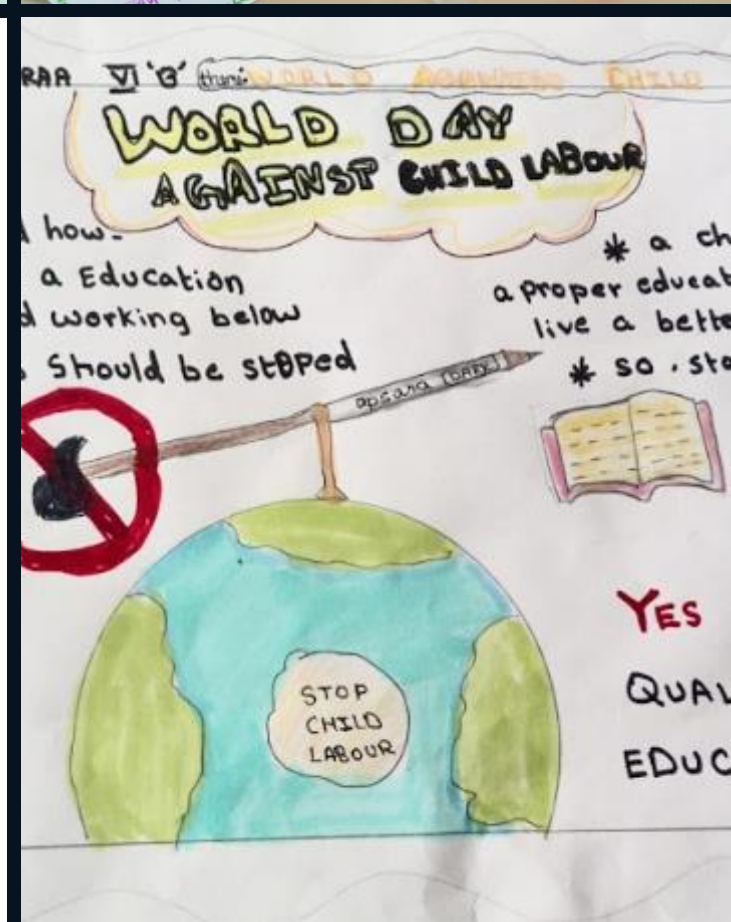

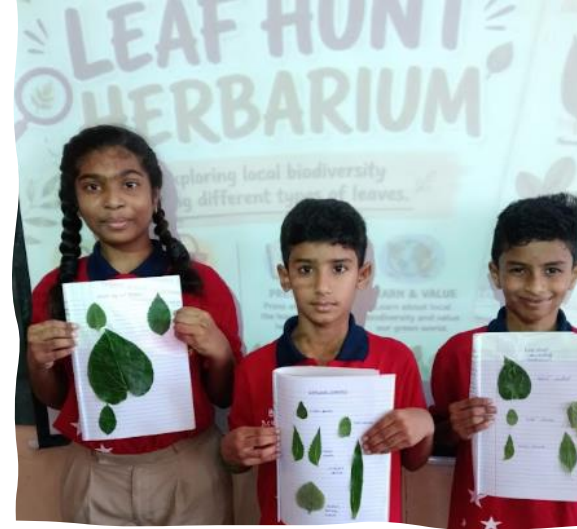


Field Trip – Marine Kingdom – 12.06.26

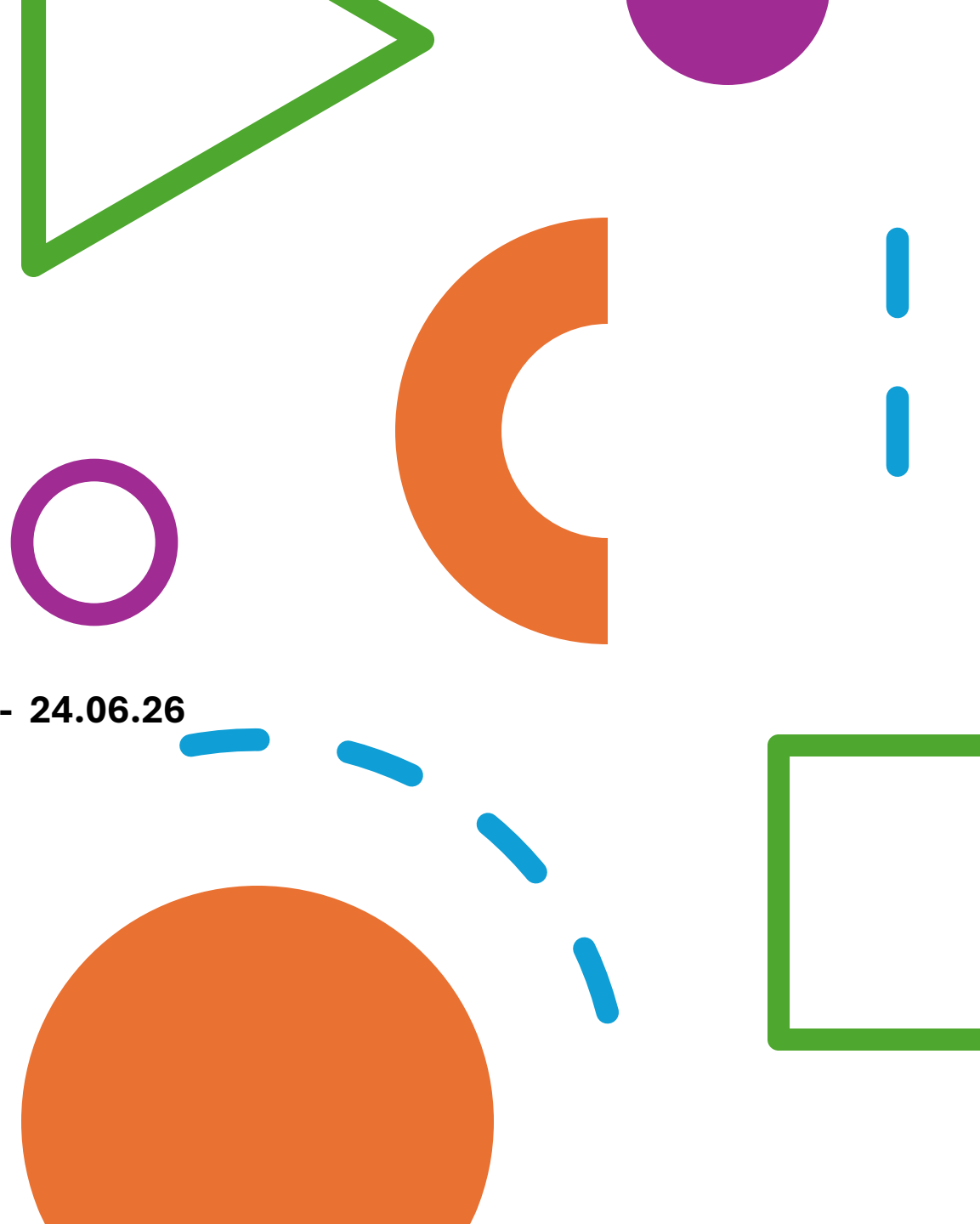
Thematic Assembly – National Statistics Day – 29.06.26

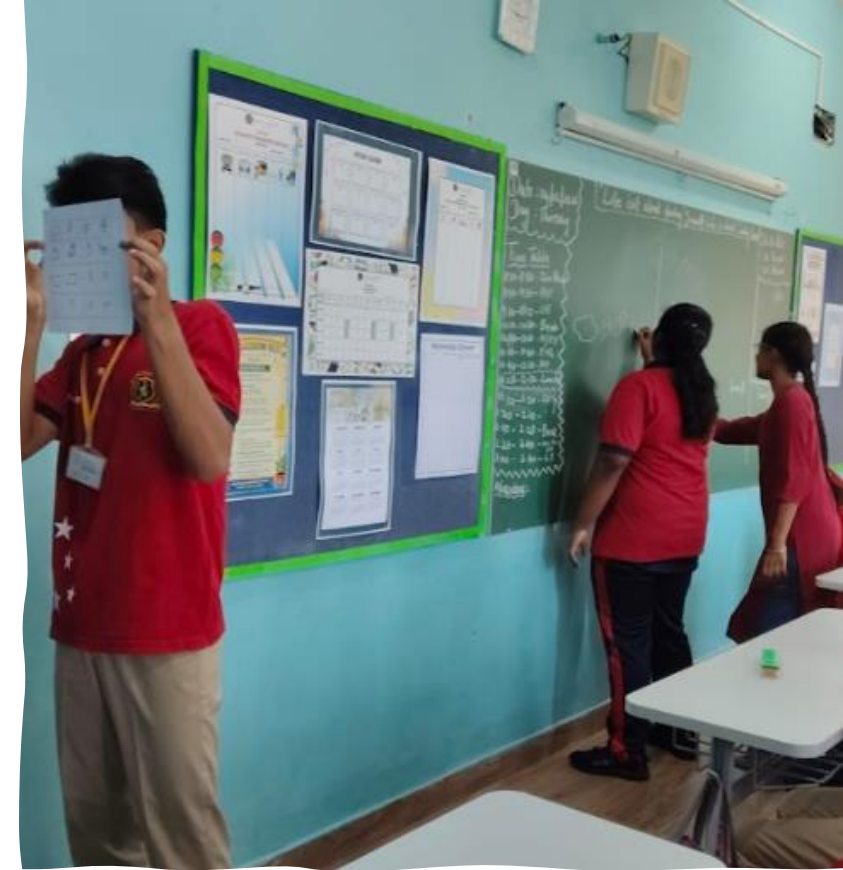
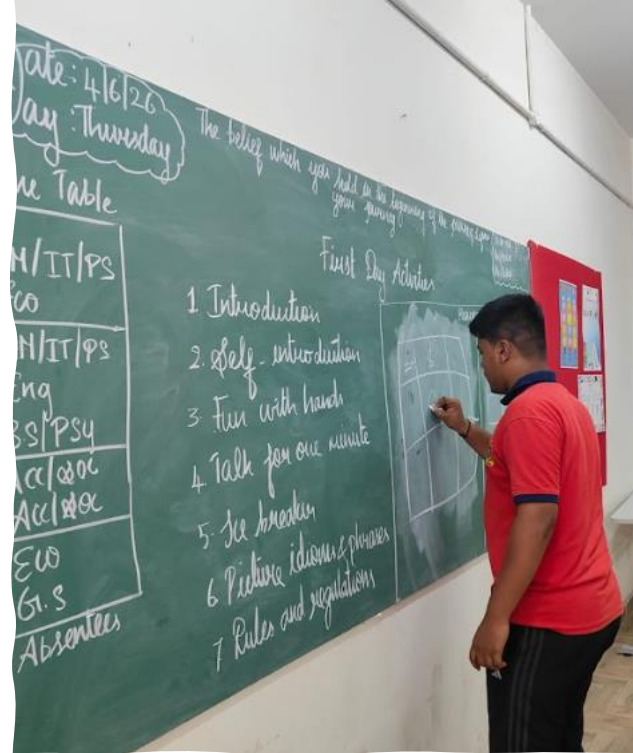

Students of Classes X-XII pledged to support the Geriatric Foundation, reaffirming their commitment to compassion, community service, and respect for senior citizens.



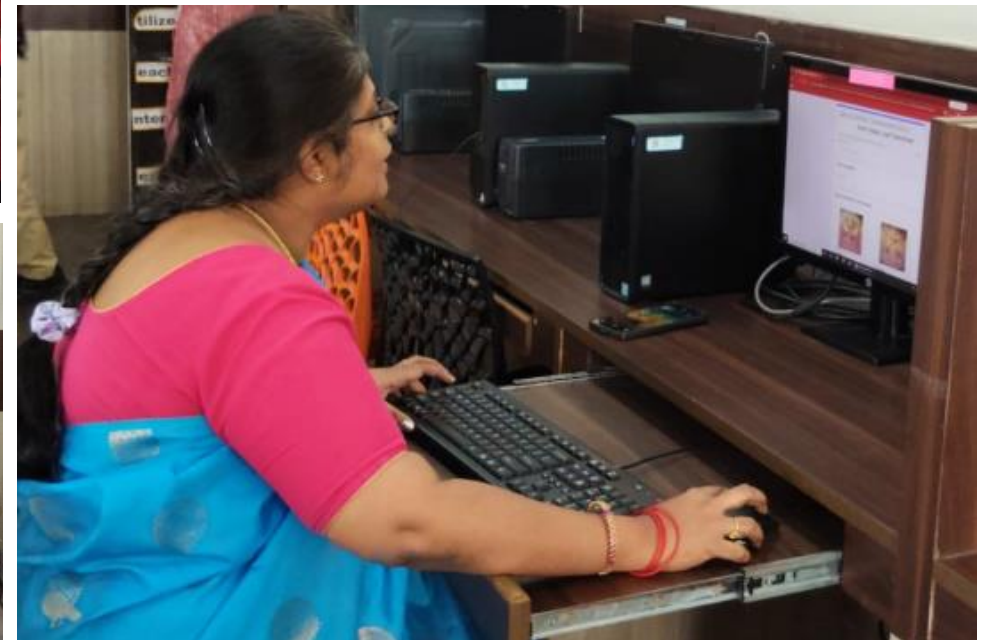
International Yoga Day Assembly- 19.06.26
