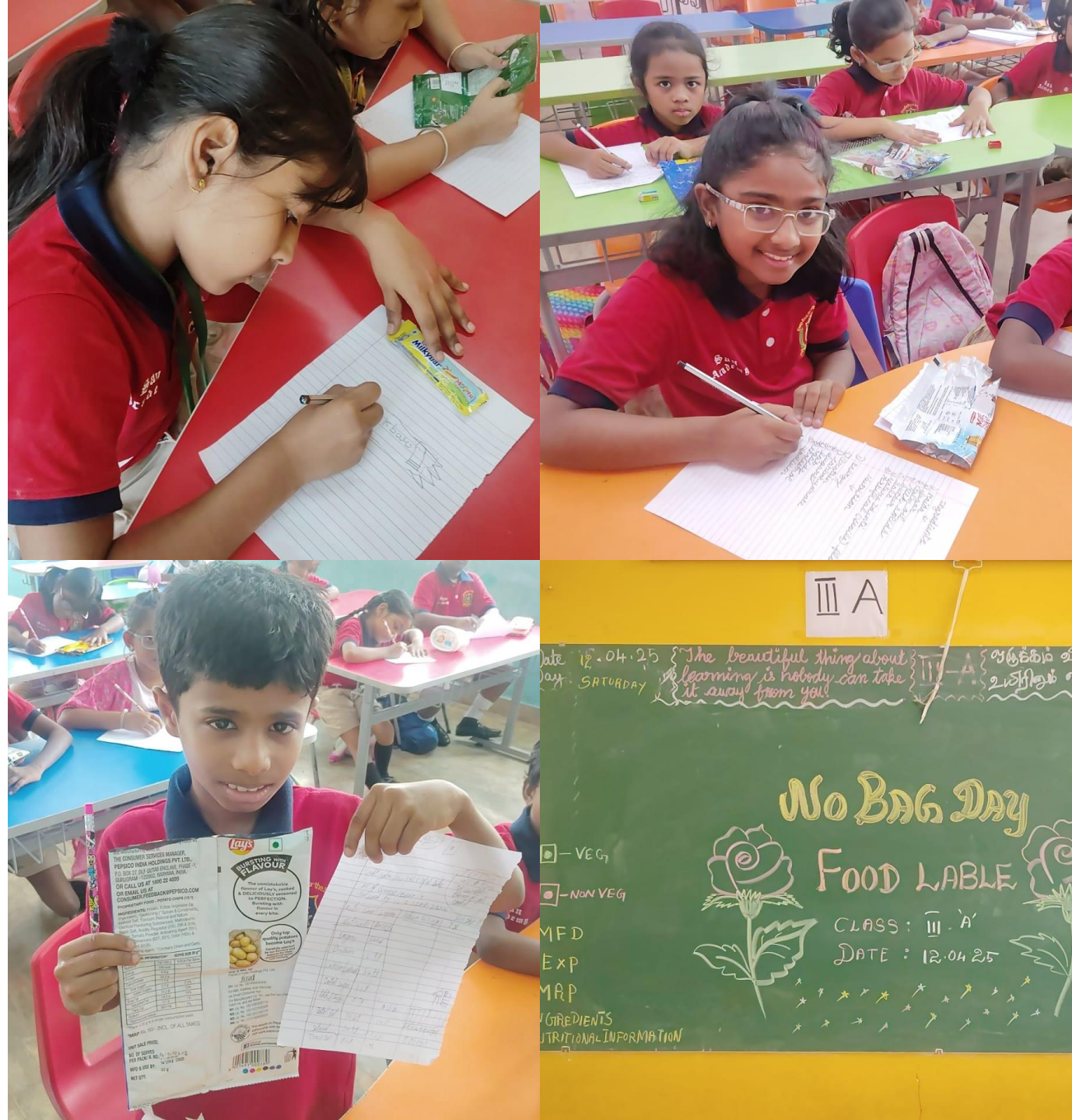
WORLD HEALTH DAY 9.4.2025 & 10.4.2025

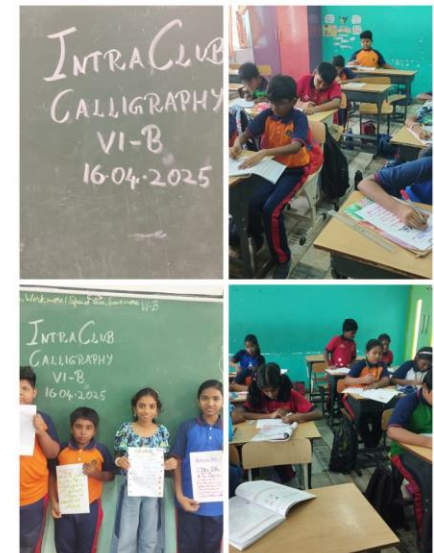
POCSO SESSION FOR MIDDLE SCHOOLERS
