WHAT IS CALLIGRAPHY CLUB?

Calligraphy is the art of writing by hand. For thousands of years, people in many countries have created calligraphy using a brush and ink or special ink pens.

There are several types of calligraphies available, in this club we are going to concentrate on **FAUX CALLIGRAPHY**.

Faux calligraphy, also known as "fake calligraphy," is a lettering technique that mimics the look of brush or pointed pen calligraphy using standard writing instruments like pens, markers, or pencils by drawing or adding thick strokes to the downstrokes of letters





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WEEK 1

FAUX CALLIGRAPHY

Students will learn the stroke and the shading techniques. Practice writing Capital and small alphabets with thickening the downwards strokes.

WEEK 2

FAUX CALLIGRAPHY

Once the students are well versed with the letters, students will practice writing simple to complex words with or without cursive





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WEEK 3

FAUX CALLIGRAPHY- INTRA COMPETITION

Students can make Book marks, greeting cards or any creative presentation using FAUX CALLIGRAPHY
