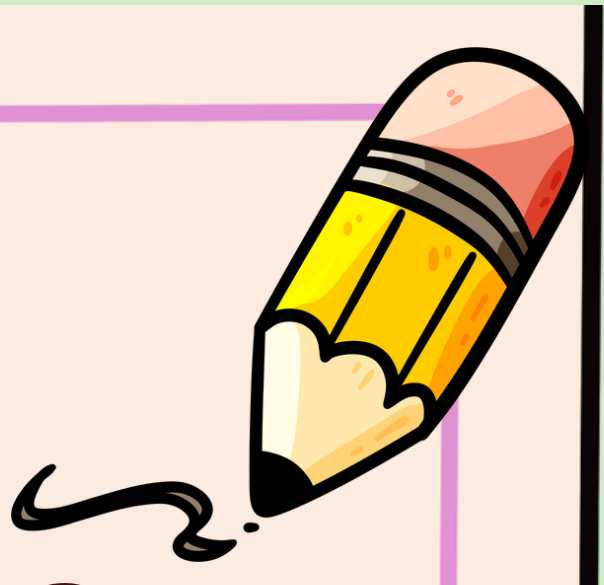
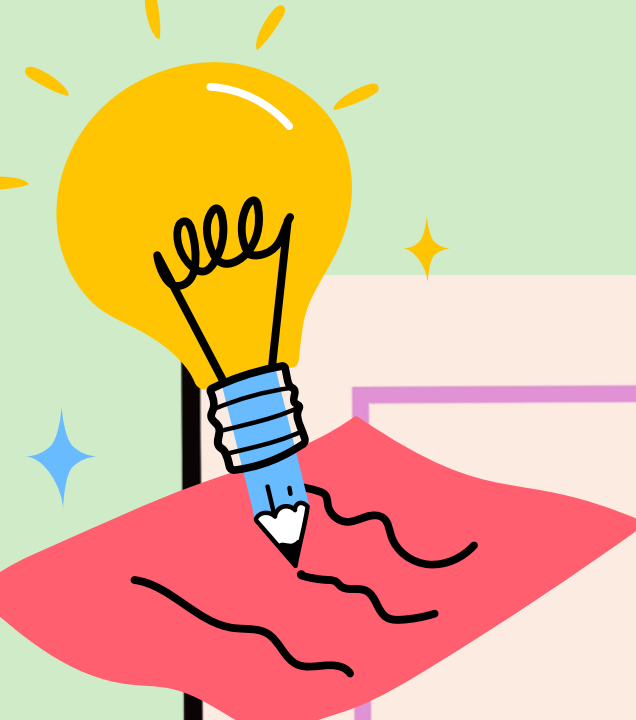

GREETINGS FROM SAN ACADEMY!

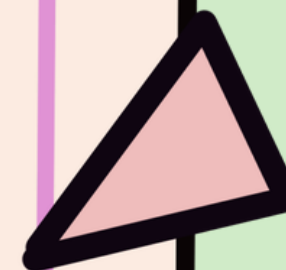

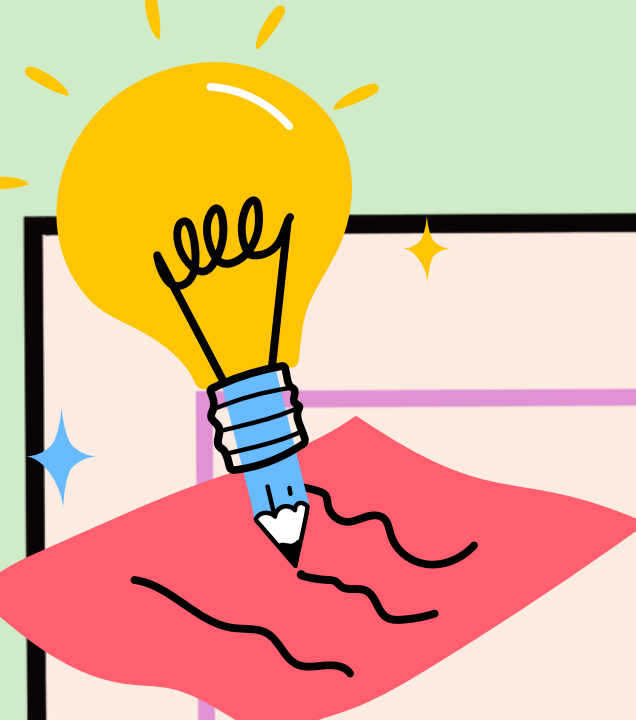

WHAT IS LITERARY CLUB?

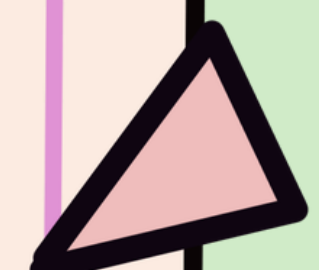

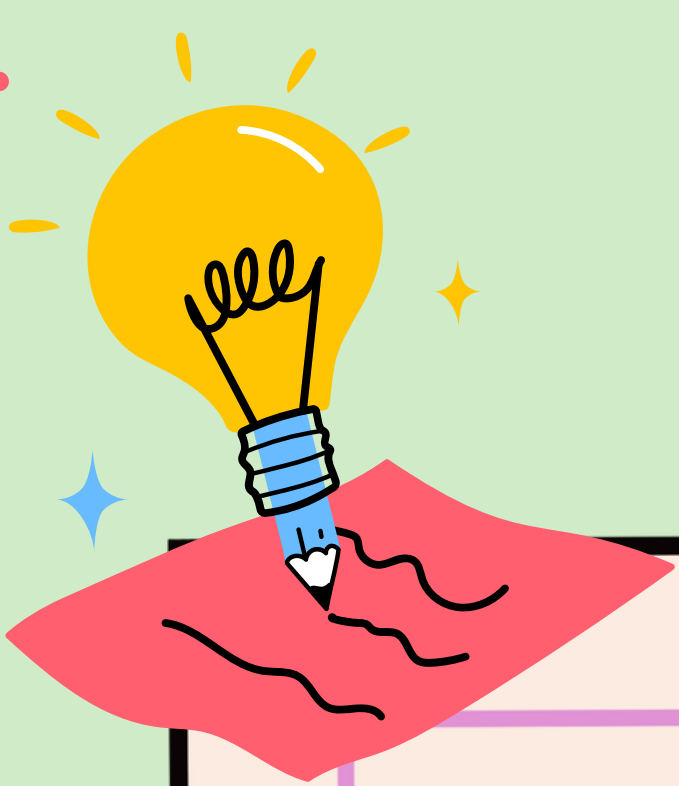

Week 1 (05.08.26)– Five Lines Challenge (40 Minutes)(GROUP ACTIVITY)

Activity Name: “Five Lines Challenge”

Description of the Activity:

Students will be given a simple topic by the teacher. They will think about the topic and write five meaningful sentences related to it. The teacher will guide them to form simple and clear sentences. After completing the writing, a few students will be encouraged to read their sentences aloud in the class. This activity helps improve thinking ability, sentence formation, and writing skills.

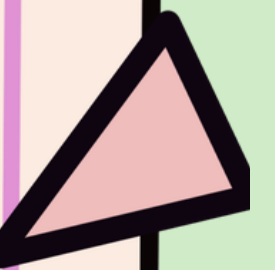

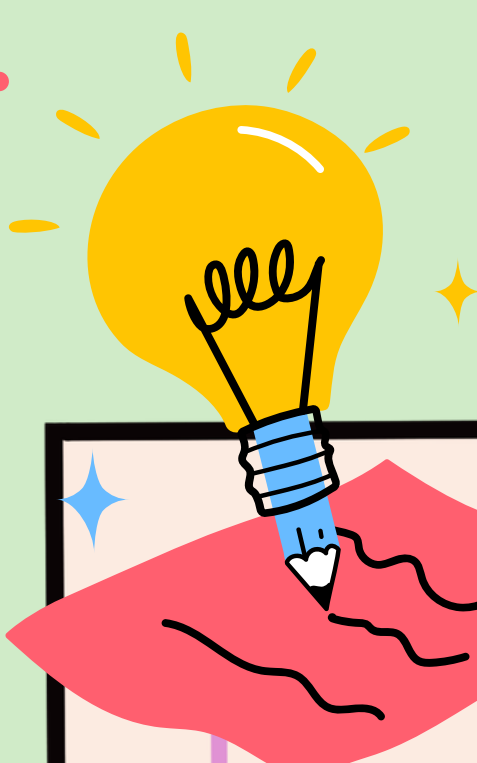

Week 2 (12.08.26) – Complete the Story (40 Minutes)(GROUP ACTIVITY)

Description of the Activity:

Students will be given the beginning of a story and asked to complete it using their imagination. They will develop the plot, add characters, and create a meaningful ending.

This activity will enhance creativity, logical thinking, and the ability to organize ideas effectively in written form.

Week 3 (19.08.26)– My Favourite Basket (40 Minutes)(GROUP ACTIVITY)

Activity Name: “Pick & Write”

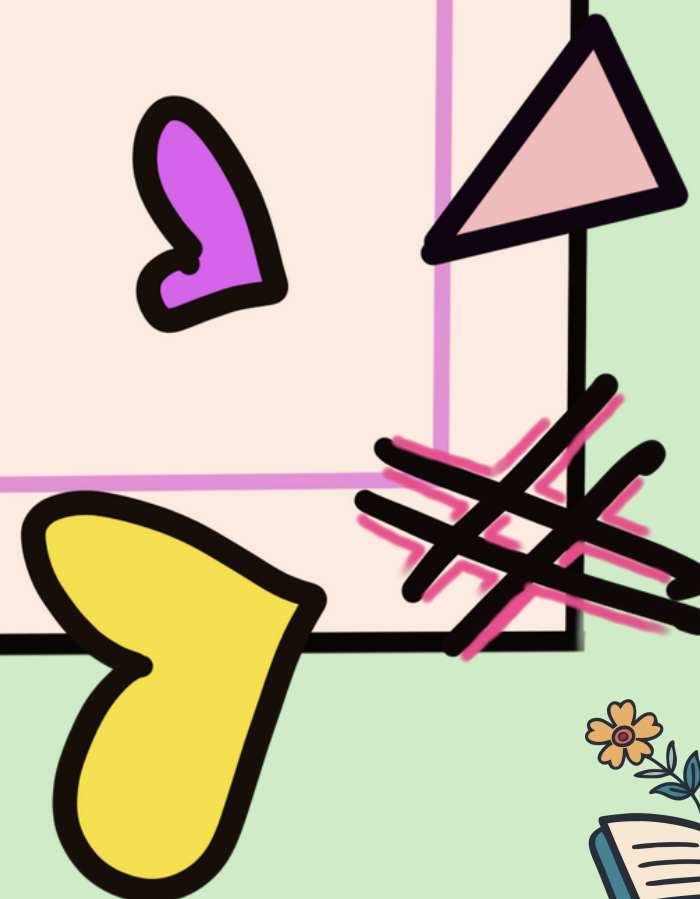
Description of the Activity:

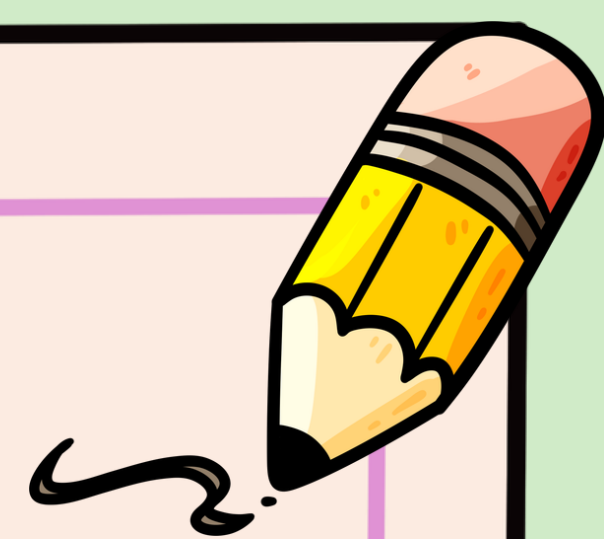
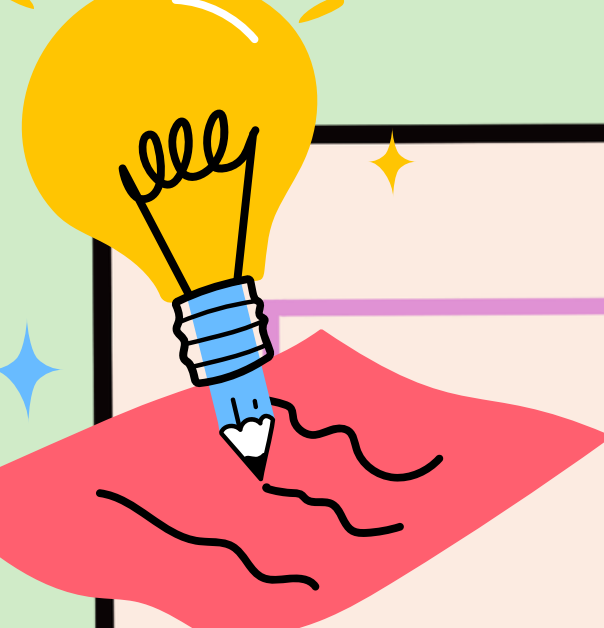
The teacher will prepare a small “Favourite Basket” with picture cards (food, animals, toys, colours, games, etc.). Each student will pick one card from the basket and talk about why it is their favourite. After the discussion, students will write 3–5 simple sentences about the picture they selected. A few students can share their answers with the class.

This activity encourages speaking, thinking, and simple writing skills in a fun and creative way.

Week4 (26.08.26) – Intra Competition: Enchanted Treasure Box(40 Minutes)
(GROUP ACTIVITY)

Description of the Activity:

Students will be introduced to an Enchanted Treasure Box containing magical objects. The teacher will reveal one magical object from the treasure box (picture cards of Magic Wand, Flying Carpet, Golden Key & Wishing Star) and encourage students to imagine its special powers. Students will write 5–6 meaningful sentences describing what the object can do, how they would use it, or the magical adventure they would experience with it. They will be encouraged to use their imagination, appropriate vocabulary, and complete sentences.
