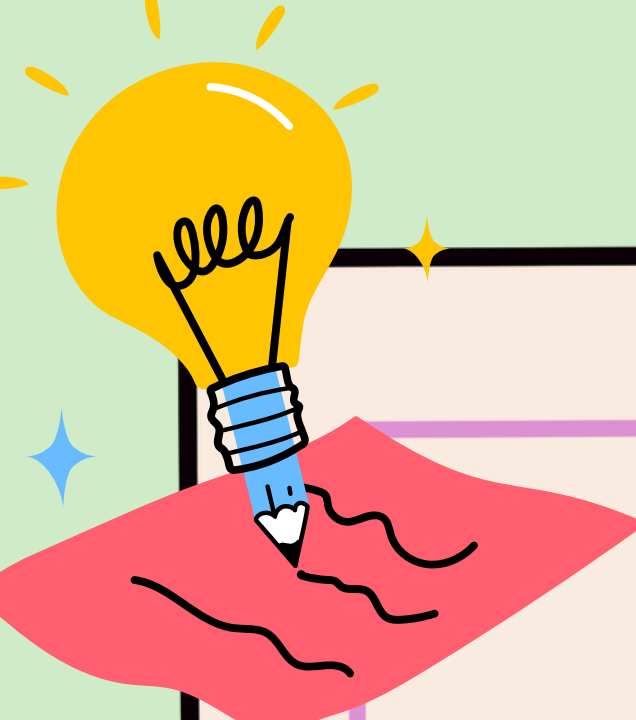

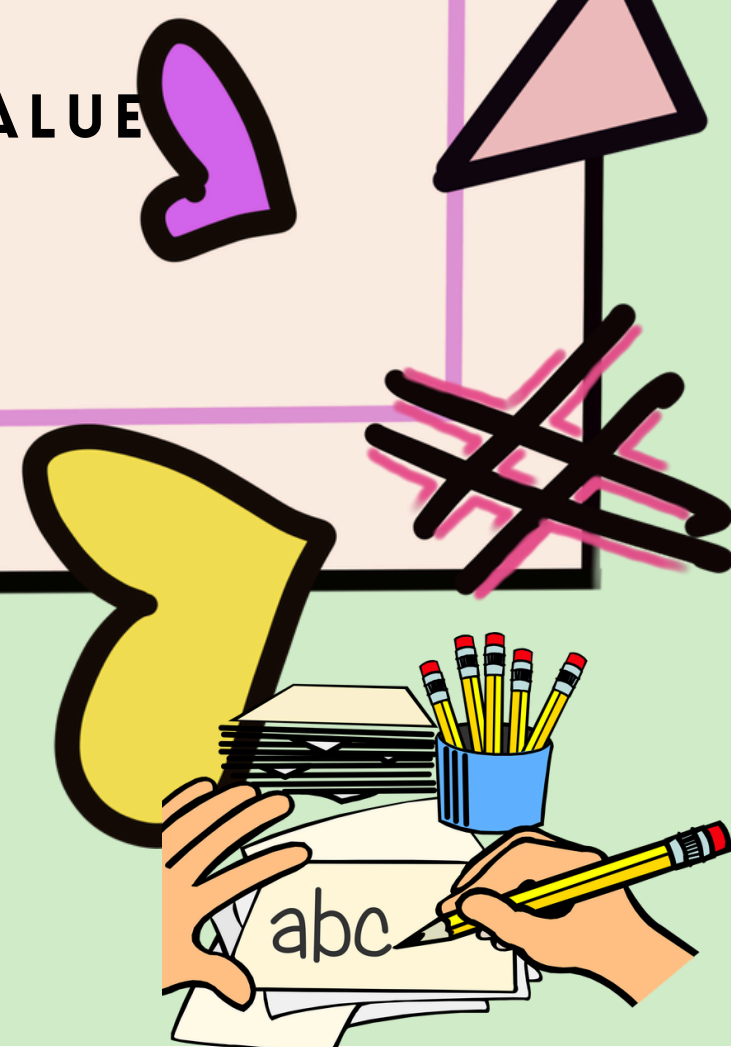

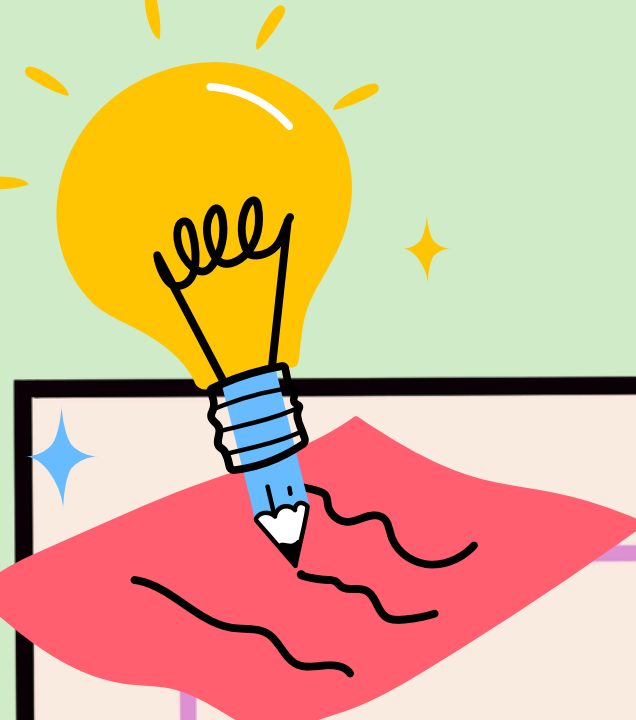

WHAT IS LITERARY CLUB?

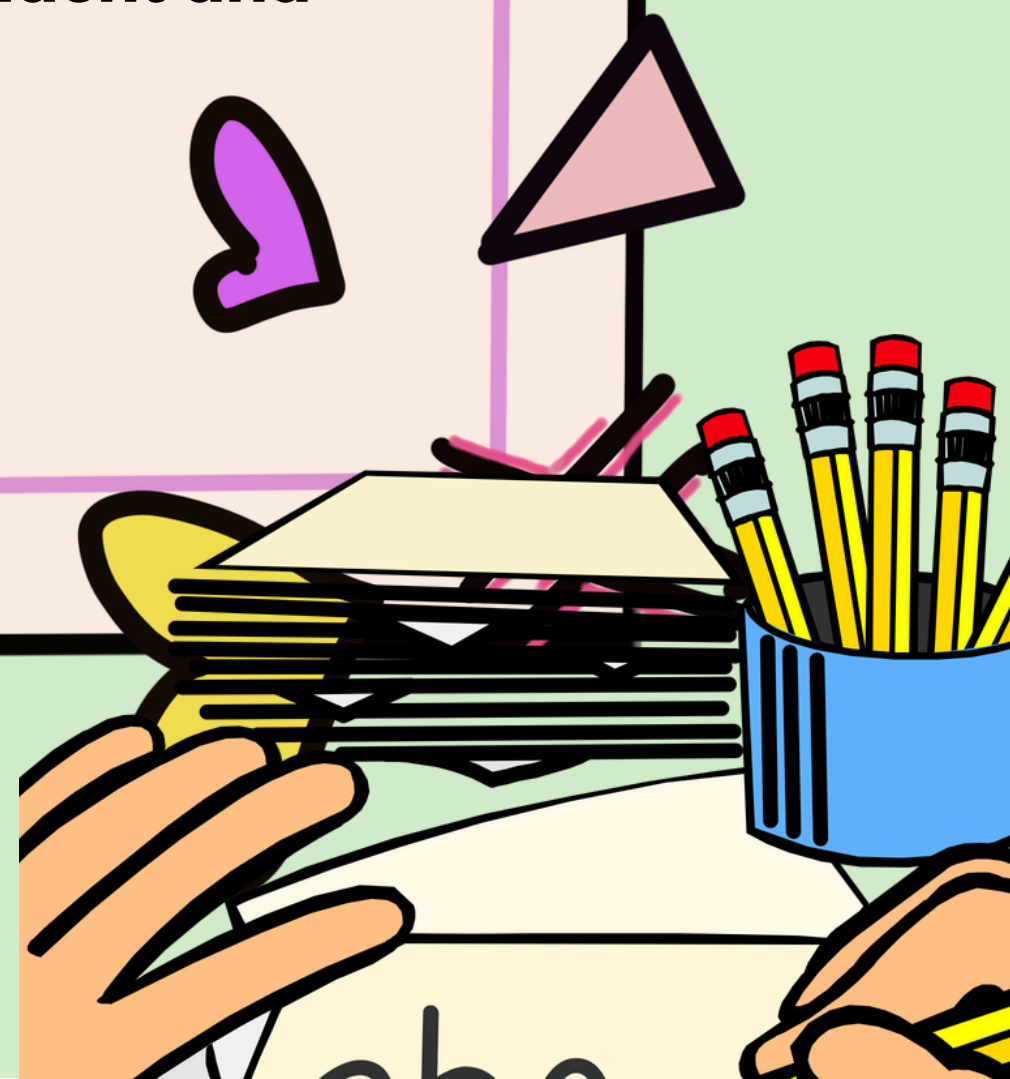

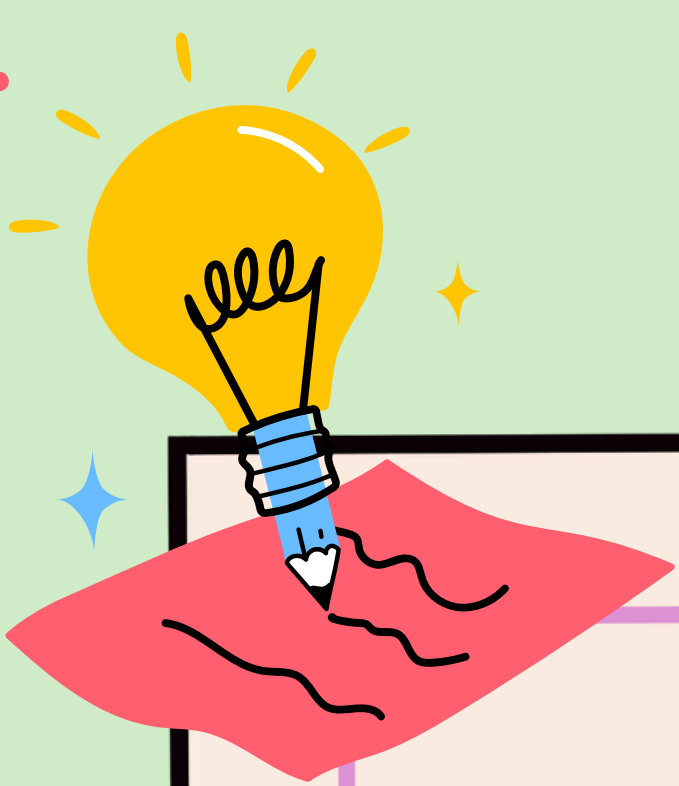

Week 2 (12.08.2026)

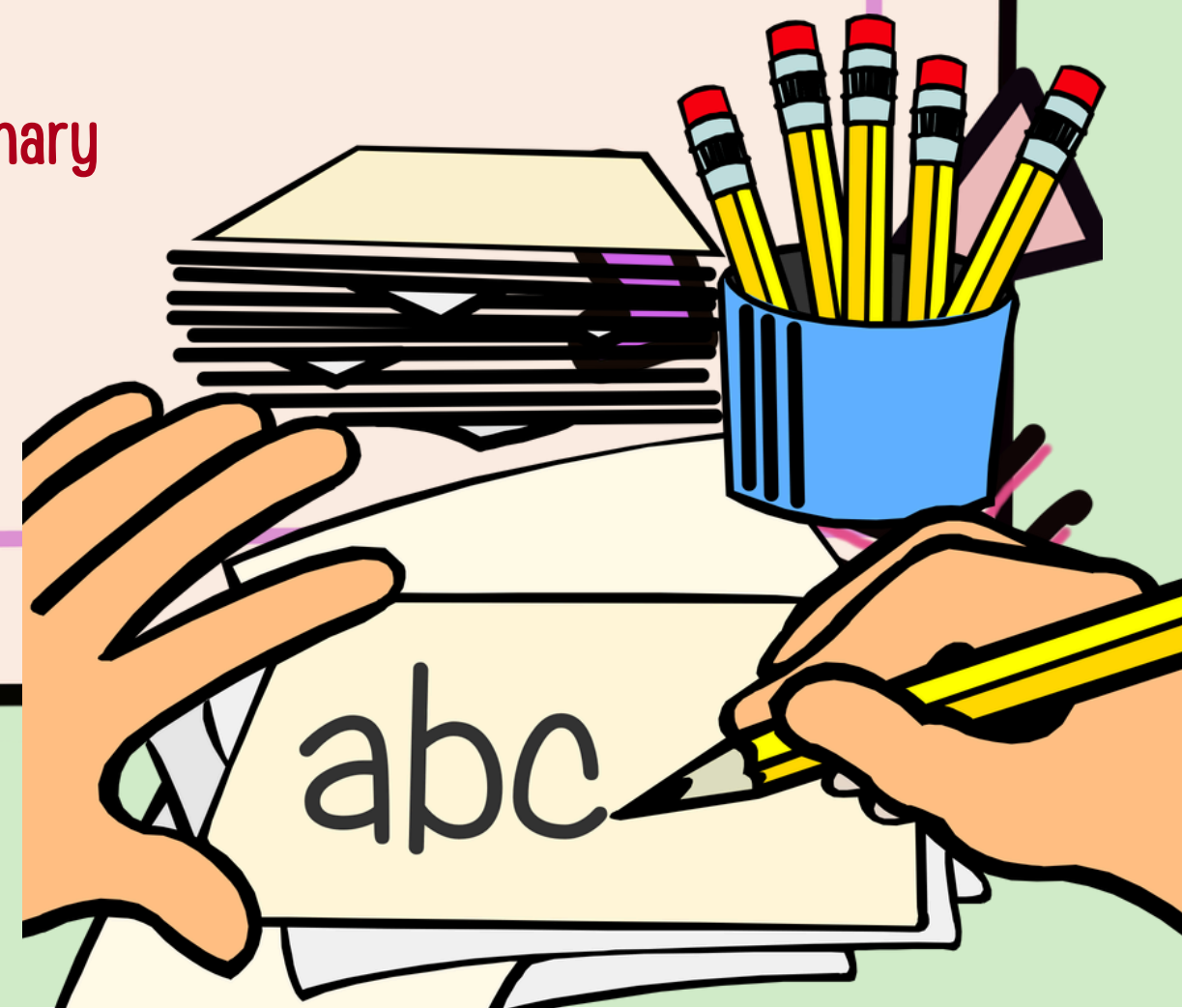
Activity - Picture Comprehension (40 Minutes)(GROUP ACTIVITY)

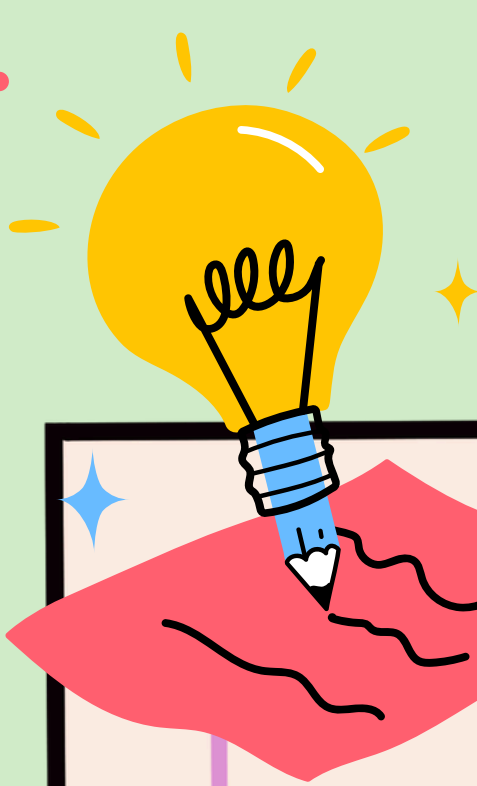
Description of the Activity:

(GROUP ACTIVITY)

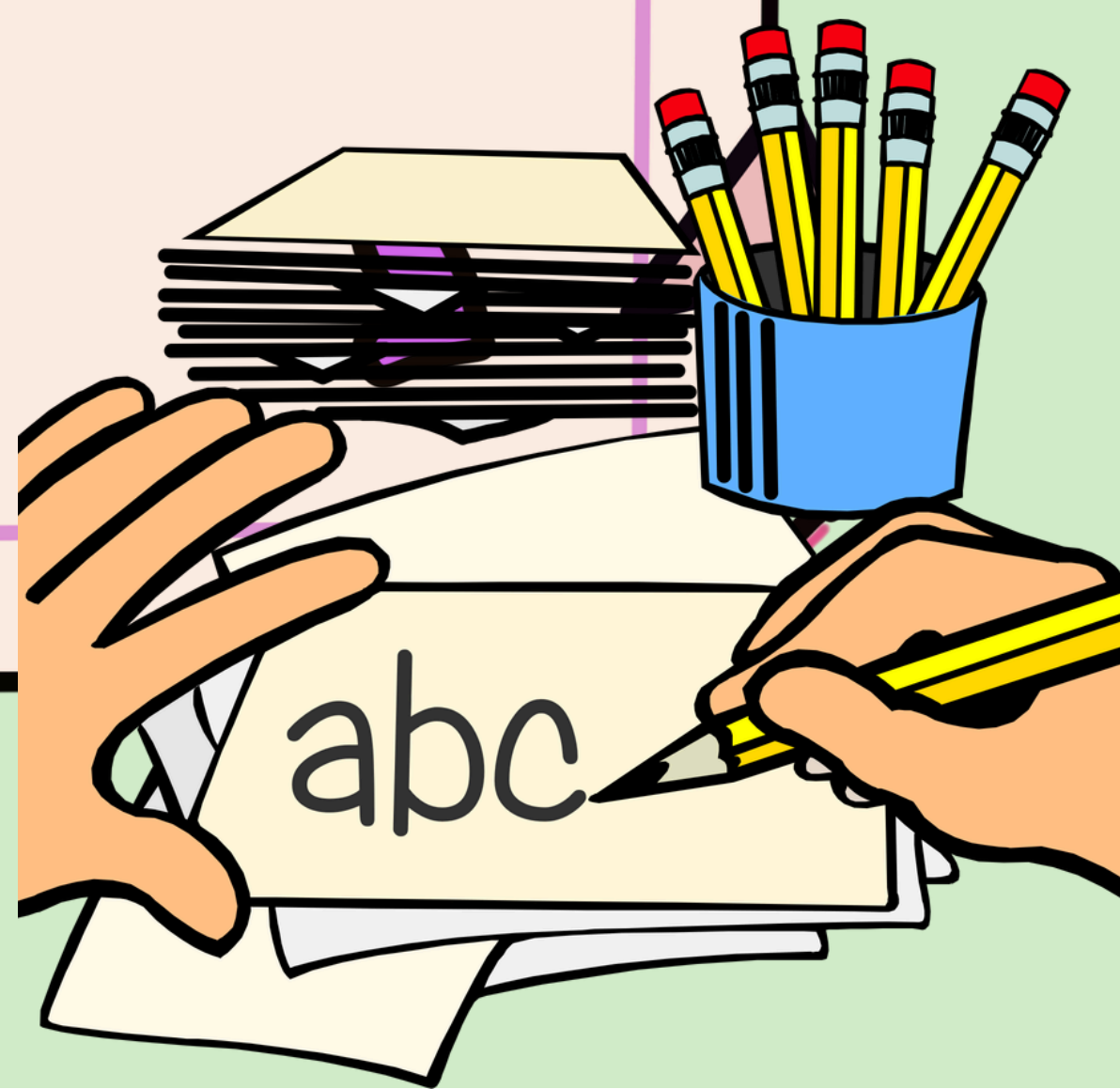
Description of the Activity:

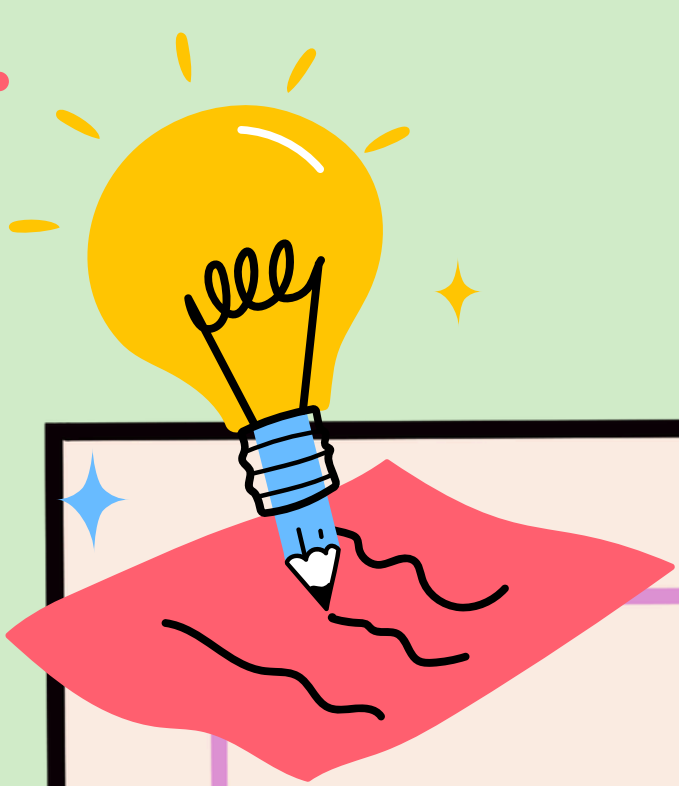
