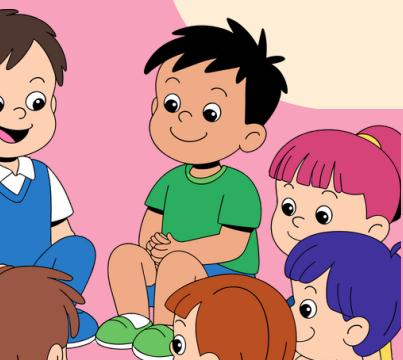

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WHAT IS LITERARY CLUB?

It offers activities like storytelling, poems, vocabulary games, and discussions to enhance imagination, communication, and confidence. Sessions are conducted in English on alternate months, allowing students to deepen their appreciation of language and literature.

The club nurtures critical thinking, creativity, and a love for literature. Regular activities and competitions strengthen reading, writing, and speaking skills. It also promotes cultural awareness and helps students connect meaningfully with diverse literary works..

JULY - LISTENING LEADERS

This month, our Listening Club will focus on strengthening students' listening and comprehension skills. Through engaging activities such as Listen and Spell, Pass the Secret, and Story Map Listening, students will practice attentive listening and comprehension. The competition, "Draw What You Hear," will encourage them to listen carefully and express their understanding creatively. These activities will help improve focus, listening accuracy, and active participation.





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Week 1 (01.07.2026)- Listen & Spell (40 Minutes)

Description of the Activity:

The session will focus on improving students' listening and spelling skills. The teacher will pronounce a set of words clearly, and students will listen carefully and write the correct spellings.

After completing the activity, the correct spellings will be discussed. This activity will help students improve their listening accuracy, spelling skills, and vocabulary.

Materials Required:

Notebook or paper
Pencil / pen

Skills Developed:

Listening skills, spelling accuracy, and vocabulary development.





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Week 2 (15.07.2026) - Pass the Secret (40 Minutes)

Description of the Activity:

Students will sit in a circle. The teacher will whisper a short sentence to the first student. Each student will listen carefully and pass the message to the next person until it reaches the last student.

The last student will say the message aloud, and it will be compared with the original sentence. This activity will help students improve their listening skills, concentration, and communication.

Materials Required:

Notebook or paper
Pencil / pen

Skills Developed:

Listening skills, concentration, and memory.





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Week 3 (22.07.2026) - Story Map Listening (40 Minutes)
Description of the Activity:

The session will focus on developing listening comprehension and understanding of story structure. Students will listen carefully to a short story narrated by the teacher. After listening, they will complete a Story Map worksheet by identifying key elements of the story.

The Story Map will include:

- 1.Characters
- 2.Setting
- 3.Problem
- 4.Events
- 5.Solution

This activity will help students understand how a story is organized and improve their listening and comprehension skills.

Materials Required:

A4 Sheet
Pencil / pen

Skills Developed:

Listening comprehension, understanding of story structure, and critical thinking.





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**Week 4 (29.07.2026) - Intra Competition:
Draw What You Hear (40 Minutes)**

Description of the Activity:

The session will conduct an intra-class competition titled Draw What You Hear. The teacher will describe a scene or setting in detail. Students will listen carefully and draw the scene based on what they imagine.

Materials Required:

- A4 sheets
- Pencils and erasers
- Crayons / colour pencils
- Sharpener
- Clipboard or drawing board (optional)

Judging Criteria:

- Accuracy in listening and drawing the described scene
- Creativity and imagination
- Neatness and presentation
- Attention to details from the description
- Overall visual representation
