DAY 1: (10.06.26) WEDNESDAY

Activity: Practice(LEAF ART)

MATERIALS REQUIRED:Leaves,Glue,A4 sheets,Sketch pens

- ➔ Students will be introduced to leaf art, a creative activity using natural leaves to make pictures.
- ➔ They will observe different shapes and sizes of leaves and discuss what each leaf can represent.
- ➔ The teacher will demonstrate simple designs like a fish and a butterfly using leaves.
- ➔ Students will create their own simple leaf art using basic shapes.
- ➔ Students will share their work with the class.

DAY 2: (17.06.26)WEDNESDAY:

Activity: Practice (Creative Composition)

MATERIALS REQUIRED:Leaves,Glue,A4 sheets,Sketch pens

- ➔ Students will create a detailed animal or a nature scene using multiple leaves.
- ➔ They will begin by revisiting the previous class and observing a few sample leaf art designs.
- ➔ The teacher will demonstrate how to create a peacock and a tree scene using different leaves.
- ➔ Students will then create one detailed design, choosing either an animal or a nature scene.
- ➔ At the end, students will share what they have created and explain their ideas.

MATERIALS REQUIRED:Leaves,Glue,A4 sheets,Sketch pens

The teacher will explain the theme options: Animals & Birds, Nature Scene, or My Imagination.

Students will work independently to create their leaf art using their own ideas.

The teacher will observe and guide where necessary.

All artworks will be displayed, and students will view each other's creations.
