

# PROJECT DAY :KG


Project Day - 20.12.2019 & 21.12.2019

Project day 21.12.2019 & 22.12.2019



Ms. Aswitha Biju – India's youngest palaeontologist was the chief guest.










Learning Origami paper folding techniques 04.12.2019


Origami, the ancient art of paper folding, has applications in the modern-day classroom for teaching geometry, thinking skills, fractions, problem solving, and fun science.


First day of skill club children learn making fish and other different paper folding techniques.





**SAN Picasso Art competition 21.12.2019**
