Students observed and explored variety of birds such as Peacock, Cockatoo, Macaw, Cockatiel, Crane, Egret, Heron, Darter, Spoonbill, Stork, Pelican Emu and Ostrich. They also saw animals such as Monkeys, Tiger, Deer, Zebra, Giraffe, Elephant, Leopard and Rhinoceros. This field trip enlightened the children towards caring for animals and birds in the environment.









FITNESS WEEK - I TO VI






Learning bad effects of plastic - (06.11.2019)


With the help of video clips and short movies teachers guided the children about the bad effects of plastic on environment and why it is not good for our oceans.






Second week of the club was making Herbarium children got chance to show their creativity and also they learn gardening skills .These activities also develops the love for nature.
