






# TRADITIONAL SPORTS DAY-KG






# SHOW AND TELL - NURSERY




# SHOW AND TELL - SR. KG






# ZOO ANIMAL PARTY -KG







# ANIMAL SHELTER DAY -KG





# LET'S GO FISHING DAY-KG






# SAVE ANIMAL DAY KG




# WORLD WATER DAY I-VI






# THEMATIC ASSEMBLY- SEPTEMBER I-VI

Unity is Strength – 05.09.2019



# THEMATIC ASSEMBLY- OCTOBER I-VI


World Ozone Day – 24.09.2019

Observance of vigilance awareness: 31.10.19





Learning basics of Warli art: 09.10.19










Making Diwali greeting cards Grade I to III: 23.10.2019

Diwali Celebration – 25.10.2019




