DATE	NAME OF THE SONG	LEARNING OUTCOME
8.10.25 & 22.10.25	Choo Choo Va	Children practice big body movements (jumping, clapping, bending, swaying) which improve coordination and balance. The song gives step-by-step actions, so kids learn to listen carefully and respond promptly.
29/10/25	Shake your sillies out	Encourages shaking, stretching, clapping and moving, which improve coordination, balance and body awareness. Children practice following simple verbal instructions and matching movements to the lyrics.

29.10.25	Nature shakers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Y-shaped twigs (1 per shaker)</li><li>• red , blue, yellow ,white paint (we used acrylic craft paint)</li><li>• red /or white yarn</li><li>• red and white buttons and beads</li><li>• white seashells (with holes in them)</li><li>• paintbrush</li></ul>	The students will be able to get hands-on experience on making a nature shakers with shells and buttons which encourages creativity, problem-solving, and exploration.




# HOBBY CLUB


# SPORTS CLUB

29.10.25	Club Wall	To promote healthy behaviours among the children that they will inculcate for life.




