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



In 1232 BC , the Chinese used rocket arrows propelled by burning gun powder in their war with the Mongols.

Robert Goddard built and launched the first liquid fuel rocket on 26 March 1926. The rocket climbed 12.5m before landing in a nearby cabbage patch.

FIRST LAUNCH INTO SPACE

FIRST LAUNCH INTO EARTH ORBIT

On 4th October 1957 , the R-7 ICBM was the first rocket to launch an artificial satellite – sputnik I – into orbit . This marked the start of the space Race between US and USSR.






